

GUS MOORE WINS MET 10-MILE RUN

Shows Heels to Smart Field of Runners at McCarren Park.

Gus Moore, Brooklyn's own national cross-country champion and metropolitan mile titleholder, added another championship to his list when he captured the 10-mile metropolitan championship run yesterday before 5,000 spectators at McCarren Park. The sturdy colored flyer took the lead at the start of the race in a field that listed Whitey Al Michelson, experienced Millrose flyer; James McDade, national 10-mile champion, and Frank McArthur, also of the Millrose Club.

Moore set about overtaking the field, and by the time he had finished the third mile he had lapped the chaff. He continued his phenomenal pace and overtook McDade on the seventh mile. On his last mile Moore lapped the field again, with the exception of his first two rivals, finishing in 54 minutes, 31 3-5 seconds, believed to be a new park mark.

Michelson trotted in more than 440 yards to the rear, with J. Erol Vaughn, of the Good Shepherd A. C., third. McDade finished fourth. The summary:
