

# "PERSONAL LIFE DIARY" PRINCIPLES

**Generic planet Transit Cycles** refer to the positions of planets in the Birth Chart and are entirely dependent on age. So a Birth Chart is not required. It is these Cycles that determine common human life experiences. They begin a new Cycle when they "Return" to the Birth Chart position.

**Personal planet transit Cycles** begin when they cross the Ascendant and Transit the 1st. House of a Birth Chart of Growth Stage 1 (Seed. New beginnings). This therefore requires an accurate Birth Chart.

## LADY DIANA SPENCER

Spiritual Development is essentially a lone path. The main purpose of life is individual self development. This is indicated by Maslow's "Hierarchy of Needs" (diagram below) which begins with simple Survival of birth and has the highest Stage of "Self Actualisation".

Lady Diana Spencer would be more affected by the Jupiter and Saturn Cycles than most people because she had Saturn in her 1st. House and Jupiter in her 2nd. House relatively close to her Ascendant. This means that her Generic and Personal cycles of those Planets combined to greater effect. You will see this indicated in the diagram below.

She also had a Sagittarius Ascendant. Sagittarius is naturally ruled by Jupiter.

## JUPITER INFLUENCE

---

- **1st Jupiter Cycle**

We can see that this was mostly concerned with Diana's education.

Among other things Jupiter/Sagittarius is concerned with knowledge gained from Academic Study and Travel. We note that this was almost entirely away from home (Saturn in 1st. House).

- **2nd Jupiter Cycle**

Here Diana was subject to normal development - marriage, and birth of children.

She attempted suicide for the first time at Stage 1 of the cycle.

We have to bear in mind the fact that Marriage is a combination of 2 Birth Charts and the male Birth Chart tends to take precedence. This was the case for Diana.

**Here is an extract from Charles' "Life Diary" that shows how both his marriages occurred at exactly the same Stages.**

**Typically for a woman, both children were born at Cycle of Growth Stage 10 (Peak. Harvest).**

- Prince William at Generic/Personal Jupiter Stage 10
- Prince Harry at Generic/Personal Saturn Stage 10 and Personal Jupiter Stage 1.

### **2nd Jupiter Cycle : Stage 11 (Discontent)**

Cycle of Growth Stage 11 is naturally ruled by Aquarius/Uranus which, among other things, are associated with Individuality, Rebellion, and Revolution. It is notable that Diana refused to give in to the Queen's request at this time.

### **2nd Jupiter Cycle : Stage 12 (Withdrawal. Confinement)**

**OFFICIAL divorce. New partner.** This is the last Stage in the Cycle. Events often occur at this time in order to prepare for new life experiences at the following Cycle of Growth Stage 1 (Seed. New Beginnings)

- **3rd Jupiter Return**

Towards the end of her life Diana represented the Queen abroad, and finally managed to achieve global recognition in her own right when she used her social profile to help land mine victims and support the "Ottawa Treaty" do ban land mines globally.

Diana died the year after after her official divorce from Charles and first public appearances based on her own individual personality rather than as a royal representative.

## SATURN INFLUENCE

---

- **1st. House Saturn**

A Birth Chart 1st. House Saturn makes for less Free Will in life, and a lot of hard work, but one is virtually "forced to succeed" by making changes at the right times in accordance with "The Cycle of Growth". This is also often an indication of an "Absent Father" as a result of death or divorce - or simply being too interested in his own activities to give attention to the subject.

British Aristocracy is mainly concerned with male children who will eventually inherit their estates. Her father took no interest in her upbringing. Diana said "I should have been born a boy".

### **Age 27/29 Personal Saturn Stage 1 (Seed. New Beginnings)**

This was the time of the unofficial (personal level) separation from Charles - as Saturn transited the 1st. House of Diana's Birth Chart.

### **Age 30/31 Generic Saturn Return Stage 1 (Seed. New Beginnings)**

This was the time of the OFFICIAL announcement of the separation. Generic Cycles are concerned with external social matters.
