#### **RFP SUMMARY**

## **Project Purpose**

The Ewiiaapaayp Band of Kumeyaay Indians (EBKI) seeks qualified, licensed engineering and design firms to prepare Plans, Specifications, and Estimates (PS&E) for the Evacuation Road Reconstruction Project in the Big Ewiiaapaayp section of the Reservation. This project will rehabilitate 3.79 miles of Thing Valley Road, a critical access and evacuation route for the community, first responders, and essential services. The project supports EBKI's long-term infrastructure resilience and emergency preparedness goals by restoring safe, year-round access to tribal lands.

## **Funding Source**

This project is funded through the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) PROTECT Program and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) High Priority Project Program. The funding supports the development of a 'shovel-ready' PS&E package that meets all NEPA, DOT, and Tribal compliance requirements.

# **Major Deliverables**

#### The selected consultant will provide:

- Comprehensive field assessment of the 3.79-mile road segment
- Preliminary engineering analysis (including soils and drainage)
- Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) road rehabilitation design
- 60%, 90%, and 100% PS&E submittals
- Environmental documentation meeting DOT PROTECT and NEPA standards
- Cost estimates, QA/QC documentation, and project schedule

All deliverables must result in a complete, regulatory-compliant PS&E package by June 30, 2026.
