Randolph Churchill, Sir Winston Churchill’s great grandson, President of the International Churchill Society will be the honored guest and speaker at the Saturday evening “Black tie” Banquet. On Friday, he will be on the stage at the Schemerhorn Symphony Hall at the start of the evening concert of the Nashville Symphony Orchestra (NSO) reading two of Sir Winston Churchill’s speeches to the accompaniment of a string quartet with music composed by Don Cusic. The NSO will then continue with its regular program on the “Holocaust”.

There are many sessions devoted to the various aspects of Sir Winston Churchill’s great appreciation for all kinds of music with the NSO Conductor, Giancarlo Guerrero delivering the Keynote Address: “Churchill did not have a Tin Ear.” on Friday morning. Sessions will continue with a Churchill theme and a then a review of his insights into the Civil War in the USA, including a focus on the Battle of Franklin in 1865 on the Saturday in Franklin, TN.

Arriving before the Conference on Thursday or staying over beyond the end of the Conference would provide ample time to visit the Hermitage, home of President Andrew Jackson, Cheekwood Mansion and gardens, some of the iconic “music” places in Nashville (the Ryman and others) and a visit to other Civil War sites in Nashville.
