## **Discussion Items:**

### **Update on Rink Roof Expenses**

- David Sutter reported that there are a number of places where the rink roof is leaking. We had additional damage to the rink roof caused by wind and have opened another claim with our insurance provider.
- Prior to the wind storm, local roofer provided a quote to shingle the rink roof and portion that connects to the canteen building with his quote for the hail damage to the other town buildings. It came in substantially less than what we initially thought would be necessary to fix the roof. However, it was almost too good to be true.
- Council is currently reviewing all the options for the rink roof, including the wind damage claim and will keep SRA in the loop as they come closer to making decisions.

### **SRA Bingo**

- Second Bingo was held on June 5, 2024. Attendance was up by 30 people!
- Total revenue was \$573.60. Having the gift cards donated really helps with the success of the bingos.
