- Mike Biblow submitted an updated quote from Joshua Gallant, G. Home Renovations out of Melville.
- Grant applications have been submitted to Co-Op Community Spaces and will be submitted to Painted Hand Development Corp, Cornerstone Credit Union, SaskPower (specifically for lighting). Mike suggested we try FCC and the Kinsmen Club as well.
- Town Council will be reviewing budget next week. Kathy will seek approval for them to pick up the remainder of the costs above and beyond fundraising.
- Mayor Debbie Banks has committed that no decisions will be made without SRA approval, so if council agrees next Wednesday, we will look to schedule a quick meeting after that so that we can get someone (a reputable someone) booked to do the work this summer.

The Springside snowmobile club is asking for your assistance with expenses. The club maintains approximately 60 kilometers of groomed trails. There trails serve to attract others to our community, but mostly provide a safe environment for many families in the immediate Springside area to enjoy. The club also maintains a warm up again north of Springside on the trail, with plans to add one more. Throughout the winter the trail requires signage and grooming to be kept up. The grooming is provided by fee by yorkton snow riders, at approximately \$1,000 per groom. The club has not been billed for services yet this season, but it has been groomed 4 times so far. It is this expense that we are seeking assistance with from the Springside rec association. We appreciate your attention to this matter.
