

BYLAW NO 2024-02


TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

A BYLAW TO FIX THE RATES CHARGED FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT

The Council of the Town of Springside in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Title

a) This bylaw shall be known as the "Waste Management Bylaw".

2. Purpose

a) The purpose of the Bylaw is to govern the rates charged for waste management in the Town of Springside.

3. Recycling

a) All properties that have a residential or commercial occupancy shall be subject to the quarterly fee for the collection and disposal of recyclable material as stipulated in SCHEDULE A attached.

b) The recycling charge shall be payable in every case whether or not any customer material is collected or disposed of by the Town.

c) If a residential or commercial occupancy requests an additional roll out recycling cart the fee shall be as stipulated in SCHEDULE A attached.

4. Garbage

a) All properties that have a residential or commercial occupancy shall be subject to the quarterly fee for the collection and disposal of garbage as stipulated in SCHEDULE B attached.

b) The garbage charge shall be payable in every case whether or not any customer garbage is collected or disposed of by the Town.

c) If a residential or commercial occupancy requests an additional roll out garbage cart, the fee shall be as stipulated in SCHEDULE B attached.

5. Billing

a) Fees for waste management shall cover a period of three successive months (quarterly) and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty (30) days following the billing date.

b) Customers set up on or removed from an account within any quarterly billing cycle with have charges prorated for each day the services are provided.

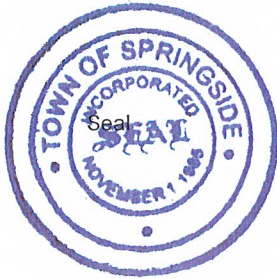
6. Penalties on Unpaid Fees


a) The fees for waste management shall be included with the Quarterly Water and Sewer Rates and Infrastructure Levy fees as listed in the Utility Rate Bylaw or as amended from time to time.

b) Unpaid waste management fees may be added to and form part of the taxes on the property for which the waste management service was provided, in accordance with section 369 of *The Municipalities Act*.

7. Effective Date

The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing.
