- Support the team in a positive manner (Pick them up, never put them down).
- Participants will not use alcohol, drugs (including marijuana) and/or tobacco products.
- It is strictly prohibited for anyone to illegally use any controlled substance, Violation of this will result in immediate termination of team participation.
- Consistently display high standards of behavior. Always control your attitude, actions and language. while attending Jaguar events. Do not engage in abusive and/or profane verbal or gestured attacks, including "trash talking" or taunting towards any participant, coach, fan, an opposing team, or game official.
- Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of each person involved in the sport. Always be excepting to the abilities of all participants.
- Accept responsibility for your own behavior and performance, and do not argue with coaches and/or game officials.
- Abide by a coach and/or an official's decision. Football players and parents must always
 accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair and called to their best
 ability.
- Do not engage in a physical attack, including but not limited to, the laying of a hand upon, pushing, shoving, striking, or kicking of any participant, coach, team representative, fan or official.
- Do not engage in any cyber bullying through social media platforms
- Do not deliberately incite unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Participants will not deliberately use rough tactics during practices and games (bullying).
- Any fan who becomes a nuisance and out of control shall be asked to leave.
- Keep track of all your equipment and uniforms. You will be charged for anything that is lost, damaged due to misuse, or not turned in at the end of the season.
- Athletes are to ride the bus for every away game, no exceptions.
- No CELL PHONES while in practice
- The athlete may not leave the field to sit with you or run errands or baby sit a sibling.
- The athlete must not miss practice. If they miss too many practices in a week, they may not be allowed to play however must attend the game as a show of support. (Coach Discretion)
- If the athlete misses more than 2 games, they may be removed from the team (Coaches Discretion)
- No REFUNDS will be given once the athlete has joined the team
- Parents are responsible for getting and picking up their child on time to all practices and games.
- Please refrain from removing your child from the team as a punishment. Please speak with the coaches if the child is misbehaving and have them assist with punishment on the field.
- There are no refunds if you remove your athlete or if they are removed.

- Although many parents may have coaching experience, please refrain from coaching skills that contradict program goals to your child. They are being taught to perform as a team, each participant is being taught a set of functions that their teammates can rely on.
- Athletes' diets are advised to be modified (Cut WAY Down on fast foods, fried foods, candies, chips (regular & ESPECIALLY hot), pops & juices. Encourage them to eat more vegetables (raw & cooked), fruits, nuts, fresh squeezed juices, and healthy snacks.
- Please note Alcohol/Drugs are prohibited in Chicago Park districts per Illinois Law and if found to be doing so can result in fines and possibly arrest.
- Athlete's bag will be checked upon arrival to the field to ensure no illegal items including drugs and weapons are on the field. If found the athlete will be taken to the parent immediately and must leave the field.

- Progress Reports & Report Cards are to be turned in for review at the next practice after they are received.
