Paul is not saying that God prevents His children from experiencing things that can harm them. He is rather attesting that the Lord takes all that He allows to happen to His beloved children, even the worst things, and turns those things ultimately into blessings... No matter what our situation, our suffering, our persecution, our sinful failure, our pain, our lack of faith—in those things, as well as in all other things, our heavenly Father will work to produce our ultimate victory and blessing.<sup>3</sup>

The difficulties of life are intended by God to refine our faith: heating it in the crucible of suffering so that impurities might be refined away and so that it might become pure and valuable before the Lord. The "testing of faith" here, then, is not intended to determine whether a person has faith or not; it is intended to purify faith that already exists.<sup>4</sup>

Suffering humbles me and \_\_\_\_\_ me to find sufficiency in Christ ALONE !!
