Season Dates/ Lengths/ No Play Weekends

- Round 1 7 games played from Saturday 29th April to Saturday 17 June
- Kings Birthday (3rd June) will remain a NO GAME weekend for 2024 season
- Matariki falls on the last weekend of June

Are our clubs happy to have no play weekends for Kings Birthday Weekend 3rd of June & Matariki 28th of June and stick with a 16 week season?



Player Registrations during season:

Players MUST register to the club database via the Netball Registration form (that links through sporty). If clubs use an alternative registration form, then it is the responsibility of the club to register these players to the Sporty System before game day so the NWC Community Competitions Officer can allocate them to the team. Players who are not registered to the Sporty system by 12pm Monday following the game played may be fined as an unregistered player.

Comms will be sent to club/school administrators after the 31 May, deadline date to remind them of the process for New Player Registrations.

• New Player Registrations will not be accepted during Quarters/Semis/Finals as players will not meet the eligibility criteria for the team.

Player cap per team:

•Previously there was no restriction on the number of franchise or National Netball League players in a team – NWC are now introducing a player cap per team of up to 3 franchise players

These are players who are current members of a club and have taken the court in the past 2 seasons, they can remain with the club and will be considered as part of the 3 franchise player numbers. We understand that some clubs will have more players listed than the capping, however, we hope that over time this number will reduce to within the 3 player cap.

- Reason: to ensure there is a healthy spread of players in the Premier 1 competition and to provide a more even competition. Pulse season aligns with our season so having teams with several franchise players in one team creates additional work for the Centre and the clubs with playing up dispensations and getting cover.

As per 2023 rule change, Additional Promotion Relegation Games rule remaining the same: (Prem 1-3, Prem Res 1)

Mid-season we have the automatic 2 up, 2 down shift between grades. Some felt that this potentially made the competition a little more unbalanced, especially in the higher grades. We would like all club's preference on the below options for the mid-season:

- Stay with the 2 up, 2 down as teams going up have earnt this opportunity OR
- 8 automatic relegation. 1 automatic promotion. 7th in the higher-grade playoff against 2nd in the lower grade to determine movement.

Please note: As in title, this will only apply to Premier 1-3 and the top 2 in Prem Res 1. All other grades will follow the 2 up, 2 down excl. the introduction of Prem Res 5.



As per 2023 rule change, Playing up limits rule remaining the same: This season we increased the number of times allowed for players to play up from 3 to 5 to cover covid related illnesses. Many of our teams found that this helped a lot this year, especially in the lower grades. We would like your feedback on the below.

• Keep the limit of 5 times playing up for all grades EXCEPT Premier 1-3. Premier 1-3 grades will revert to the 3 times playing up limit.



Dress Codes:

- A player may not take the court wearing an unregistered uniform unless a dispensation has been approved.
- In addition to the above, fitness monitors (e.g., Fitbit) may not be worn or concealed under a sweatband or strapping. Players may wear bicycle pants no longer than knee-length under dress/skirt. Players may not wear full-length compression tights (unless dispensation approved), exposed g-strings or skimpy underwear, trousers, track pants or jeans. The sole exception is for players playing outdoors at Hataitai Courts who are allowed to wear long-sleeved tops of a dark colour (black or navy blue) or another colour where it matches the uniform colour when playing in inclement weather.
- Collegiate, Senior and Premier Reserve grade players may substitute registered uniform top & shorts in place of skirt/dress. All uniform amendments must follow stipulations stated in (g). Premier Reserve teams wishing to apply for a uniform amendment must ensure the full team is in agreement to play in this variation of uniform.
- A Club Administrator or School Sport Coordinator may apply in writing to NWC for a variation from the registered uniform for medical or cultural reasons or other special circumstances. A Uniform Registration form must be completed for uniform changes stated in (f). For teams playing outside, consideration may be given to players wearing sweatshirts during inclement weather. Umpires will use their discretion in such circumstances. All direct requests in writing to NWC Community Competition.






