Founded in 2013, The Blessing Shop started as a simple yet radical idea: to provide clothing to anyone who needs it — completely free of charge. Our story began in the backlot of our church at 1320 DeKalb Street in Norristown. There, we refurbished our garage and filled it with donated clothing. Every week, people from the community came to pick out any garments they needed. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we were able to not just stay open; we thrived.



In the years since then, our shop has grown into a 7,000 square foot warehouse housing over 10,000 articles of clothing. Despite our new size, our mission has remained the same: to help those most in need.
