


# WORSHIP IN SONG

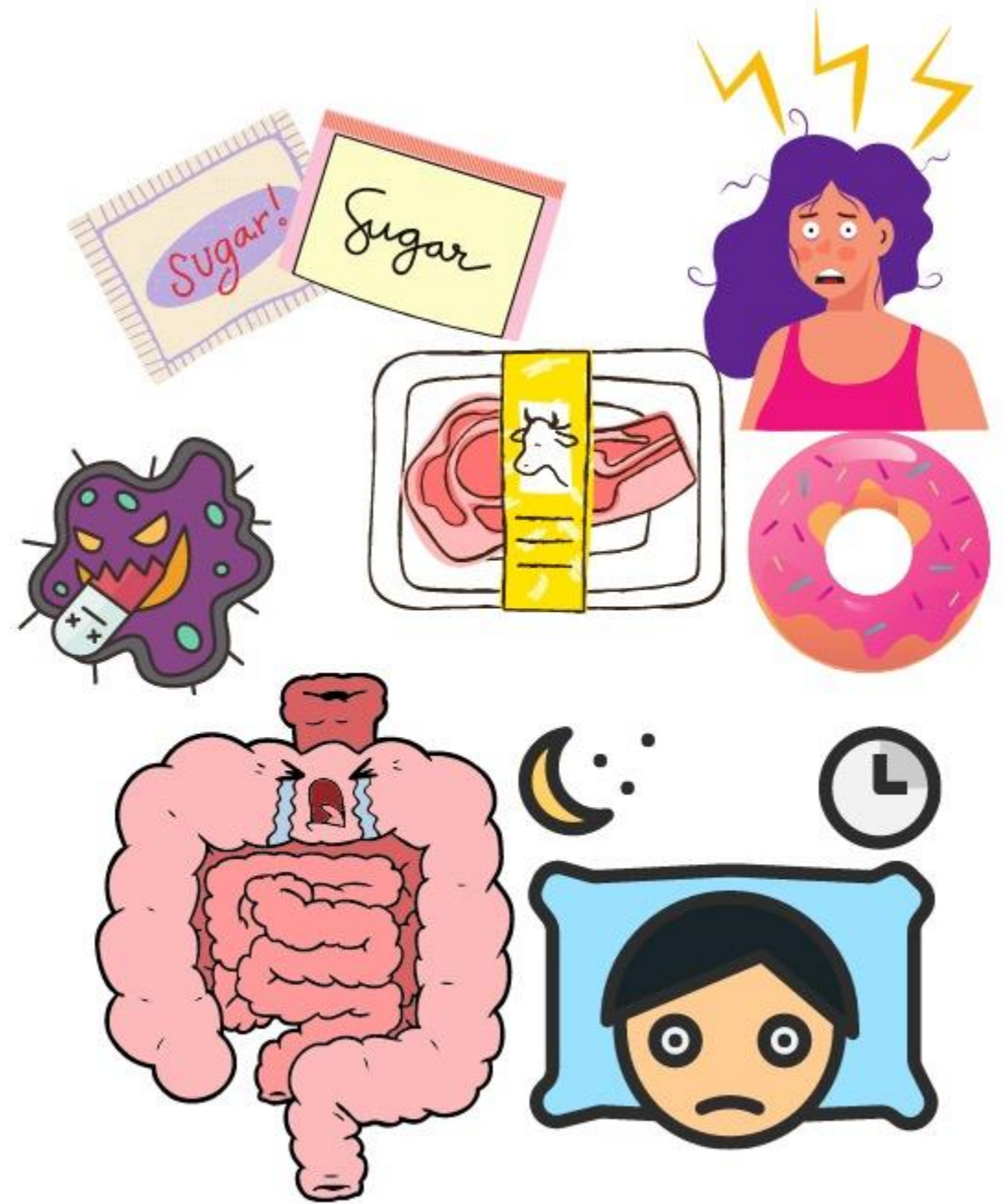

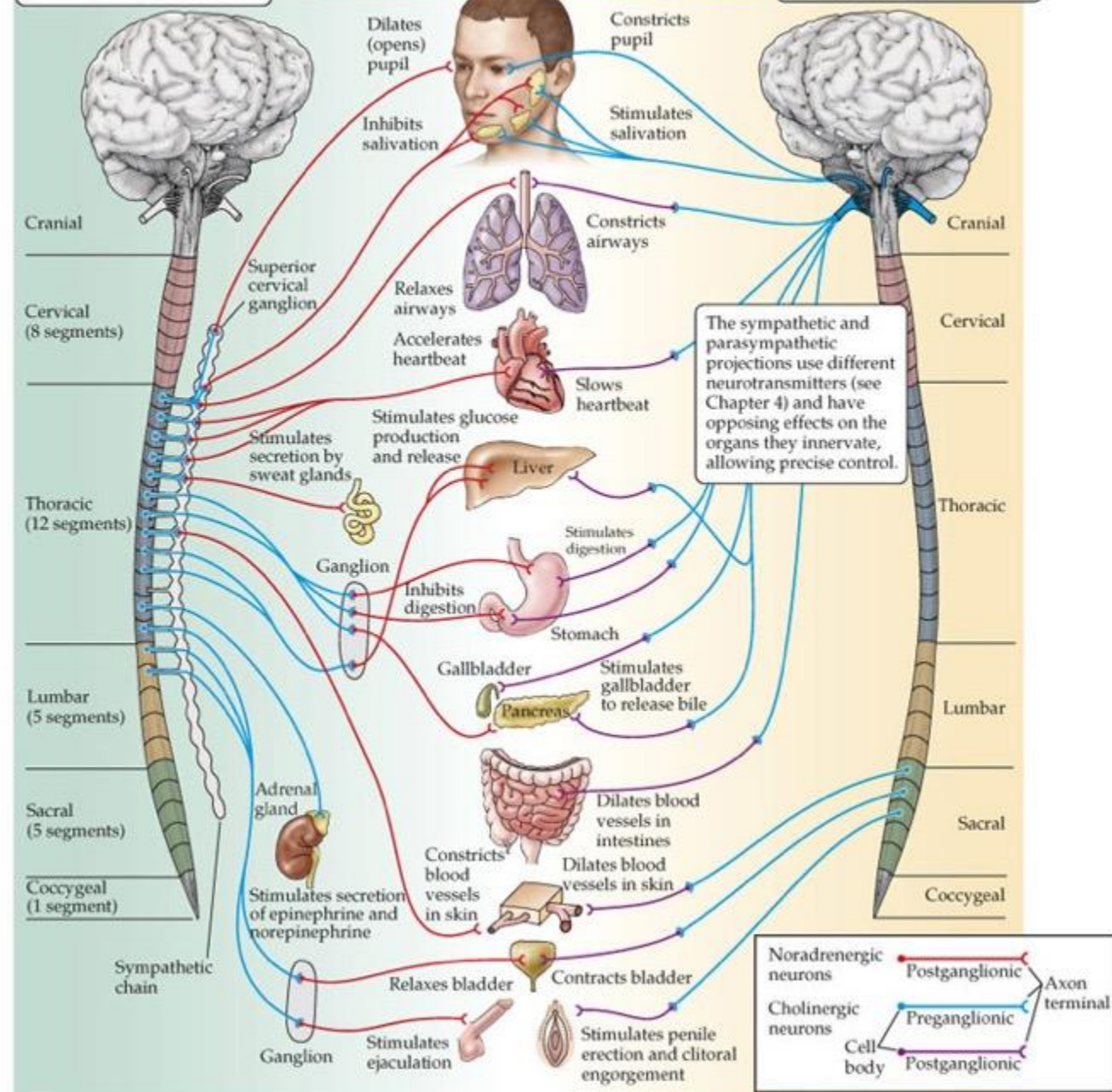
The *sympathetic nervous system* consists of the sympathetic ganglia and axons that lead to the organs. It helps prepare the body for "fight or flight."

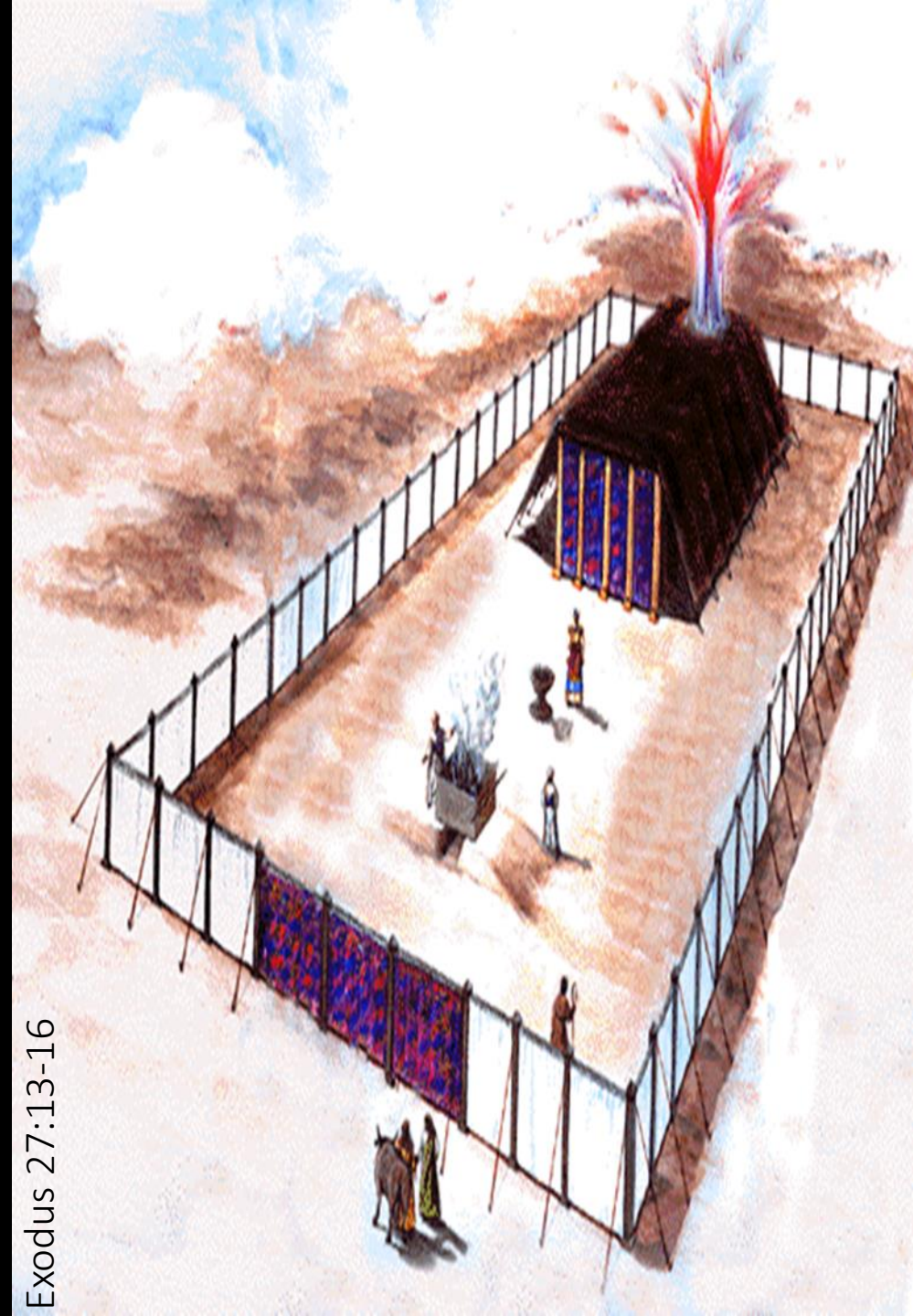
9“Then make the courtyard for the Tabernacle, enclosed with curtains made of finely woven linen. On the south side, make the curtains 150 feet long. 10They will be held up by twenty posts set securely in twenty bronze bases. Hang the curtains with silver hooks and rings. 11Make the curtains the same on the north side—150 feet of curtains held up by twenty posts set securely in bronze bases. Hang the curtains with silver hooks and rings. 12The curtains on the west end of the courtyard will be 75 feet long, supported by ten posts set into ten bases.

Exodus 27:9-19





13The east end of the courtyard, the front, will also be 75 feet long. 14The courtyard entrance will be on the east end, flanked by two curtains. The curtain on the right side will be 22 1/2 feet long, supported by three posts set into three bases. 15The curtain on the left side will also be 22 1/2 feet long, supported by three posts set into three bases.16“For the entrance to the courtyard, make a curtain that is 30 feet long. Make it from finely woven linen, and decorate it with beautiful embroidery in blue, purple, and scarlet thread. Support it with four posts, each securely set in its own base.



Exodus 27:13-16



17All the posts around the courtyard must have silver rings and hooks and bronze bases. 18So the entire courtyard will be 150 feet long and 75 feet wide, with curtain walls 7 1/2 feet high, made from finely woven linen. The bases for the posts will be made of bronze. 19“All the articles used in the rituals of the Tabernacle, including all the tent pegs used to support the Tabernacle and the courtyard curtains, must be made of bronze.



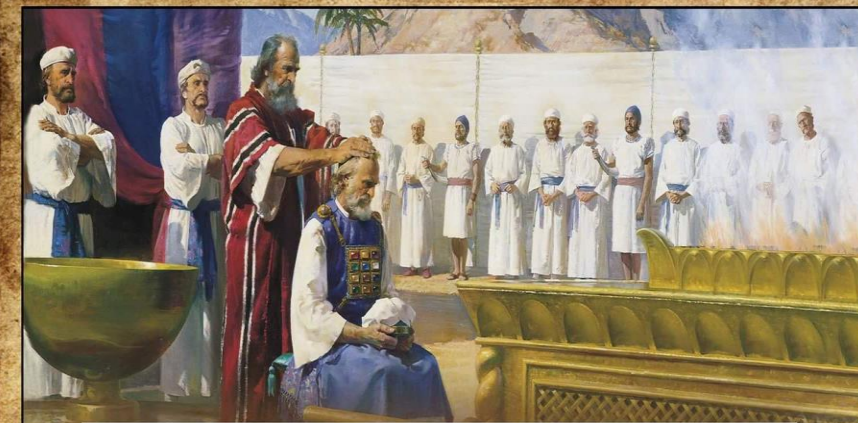

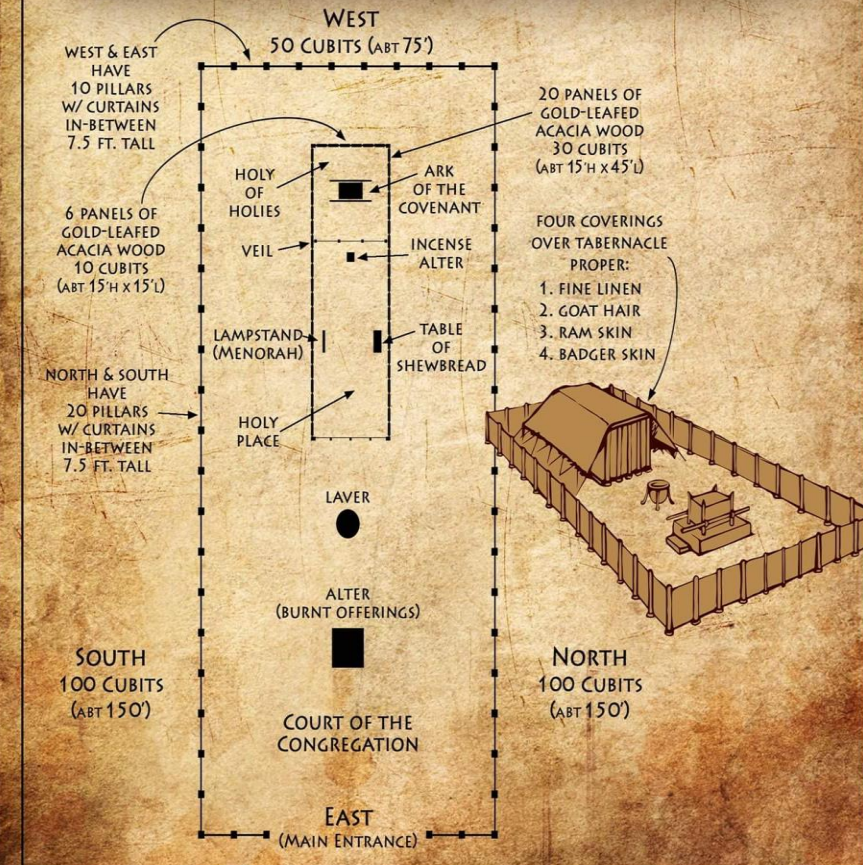

THE TABERNACLE OF ANCIENT ISRAEL





Cubit = about 18 inches or 1.5 feet

100 cubits = about 150 ft long

50 cubits = about 75ft long

100 + 100 + 50 + 50 = 300 (see Mark 6:40)

Number 3: Symbolic of perfection and completion (John 2:19; Matthew 12:40; Luke 13:7, the Godhead(trinity) Gods Righteous is perfect and complete for all

4 post in Gate

Number 4: Symbolic of the Earth (Daniel 7:3; Matthew 13: Isaiah 11:12). Four directions, four seasons The Gate had 4 posts symbolizing Christ's ministry on earth and on behalf of man kind.

Each post is 5 cubits = 7.5ft high

Number 5: Symbolic of grace (Leviticus 1-5; Genesis 43:34; Matthew 14:17). 5 Levitical offerings, 5 Sections of Psalms, The Pentateuch (Torah) The Tabernacle contained five curtains, five pillars, five sockets, five bars, and the altar was five cubits by five cubits, etc.



# 3 Sanctuaries could fit into the footprint of the ark.

Ark = 50 cubits/300 cubits (Gen 6:15)

Gate was 20 cubits long / 5 cubits high

**Number 20:** A waiting period (40 (2x20) testing/probation) For 20 years Jacob waited to get possession of his wives and property, and to be freed from the control of Laban his father-in-law (Genesis 31:38 - 41). For 20 years the children of Israel waited to be freed of Jabin, king of Canaan, who oppressed them see (Judges 4 - 5). Solomon spent seven years building the house of God in Jerusalem and another 13 building his own home for a total number of 20 years (1 Kings 9:10-11)

31 But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31

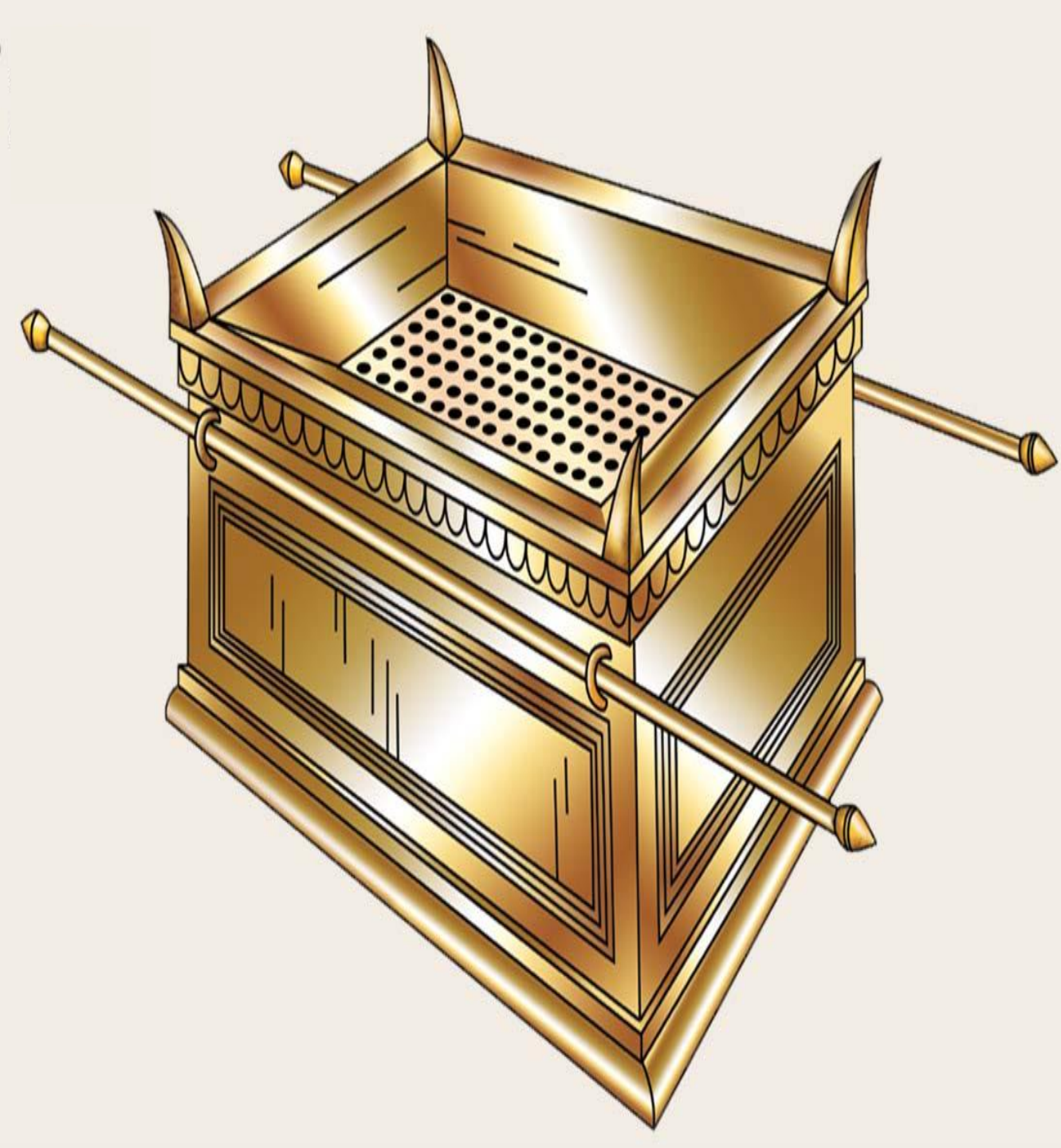
13 Verily I have cleansed my heart

# Exodus 27





Exodus 27:1-7 (see also Exodus 38:1-7)

1“You shall make an altar of acacia wood, five cubits long and five cubits wide—the altar shall be square—and its height shall be three cubits. 2You shall make its horns on its four corners; its horns shall be of one piece with it. And you shall overlay it with bronze. 3Also you shall make its pans to receive its ashes, and its shovels and its basins and its forks and its firepans; you shall make all its utensils of bronze. 4You shall make a grate for it, a network of bronze; and on the network you shall make four bronze rings at its four corners.





5 You shall put it under the rim of the altar beneath, that the network may be midway up the altar. 6 And you shall make poles for the altar, poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with bronze. 7 The poles shall be put in the rings, and the poles shall be on the two sides of the altar to bear it. 8 You shall make it hollow with boards; as it was shown you on the mountain, so shall they make





# Exodus 27





Exodus 27:1-7 (see also Exodus 38:1-7)

1“Using acacia wood, construct a square altar 7 1/2 feet wide, 7 1/2 feet long, and 4 1/2 feet high. 2Make horns for each of its four corners so that the horns and altar are all one piece. Overlay the altar with bronze. 3Make ash buckets, shovels, basins, meat forks, and firepans, all of bronze. 4Make a bronze grating for it, and attach four bronze rings at its four corners.





5 Install the grating halfway  
down the side of the altar, under  
the ledge. 6 For carrying the altar,  
make poles from acacia wood,  
and overlay them with bronze. 7  
Insert the poles through the  
rings on the two sides of the  
altar. 8 The altar must be hollow,  
made from planks. Build it just as  
you were shown on the  
mountain.



Cubit = about 18 inches or 1.5 feet

5 cubits = about 7.5 ft long

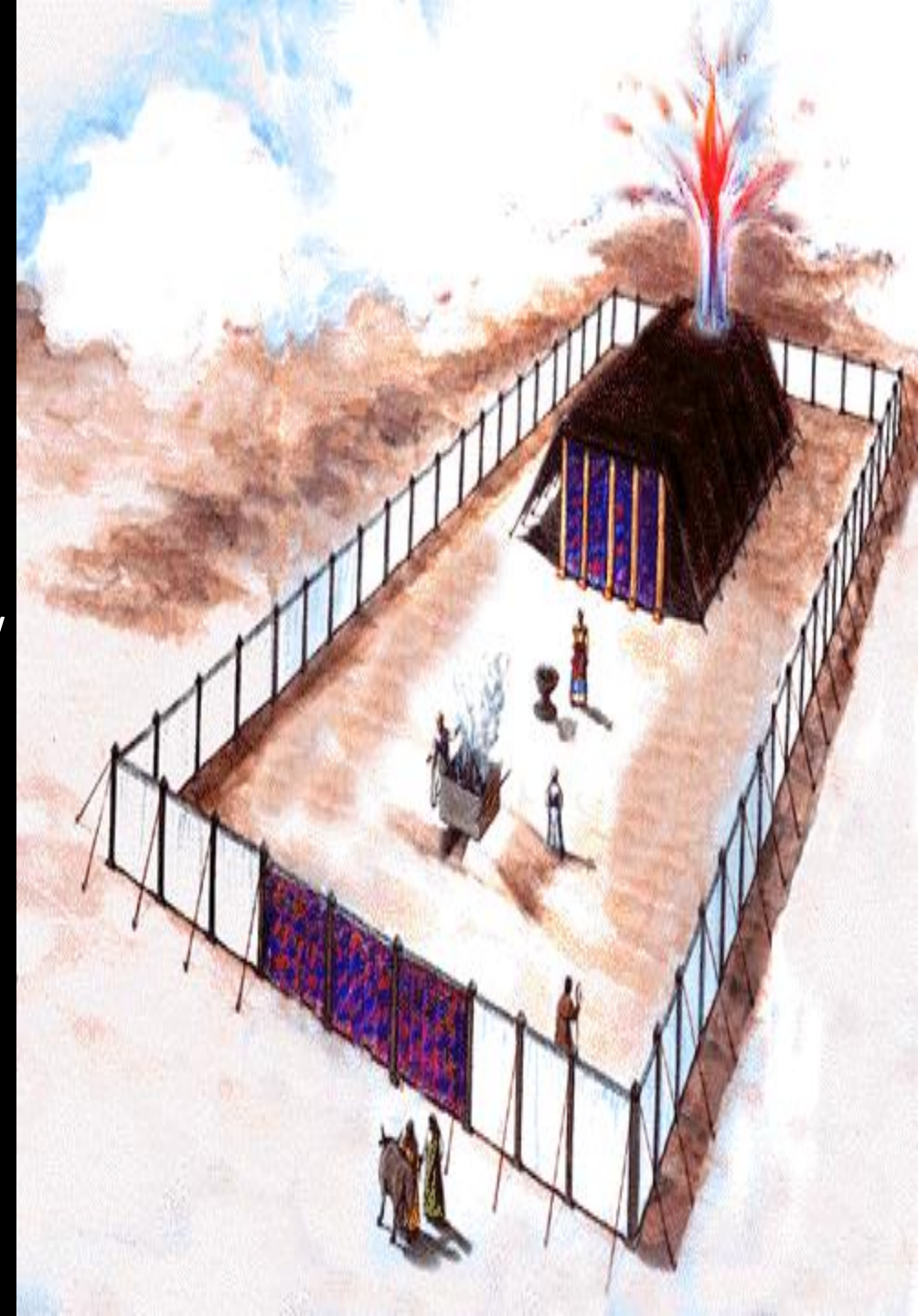

3 cubits tall = about 4.5 feet tall

Number 3: Symbolic of perfection and completion (John 2:19; Matthew 12:40; Luke 13:7, the Godhead(trinity) Gods judgement is perfect,

Each side is 5 cubits = 7.5ft l/w

Number 5: Symbolic of grace (Leviticus 1-5; Genesis 43:34; Matthew 14:17). 5 Levitical offerings, 5 Sections of Psalms, The Pentateuch (Torah) The Tabernacle contained five curtains, five pillars, five sockets, five bars, and the altar was five cubits by five cubits, etc.





# Horns = Power, Authority, Victory

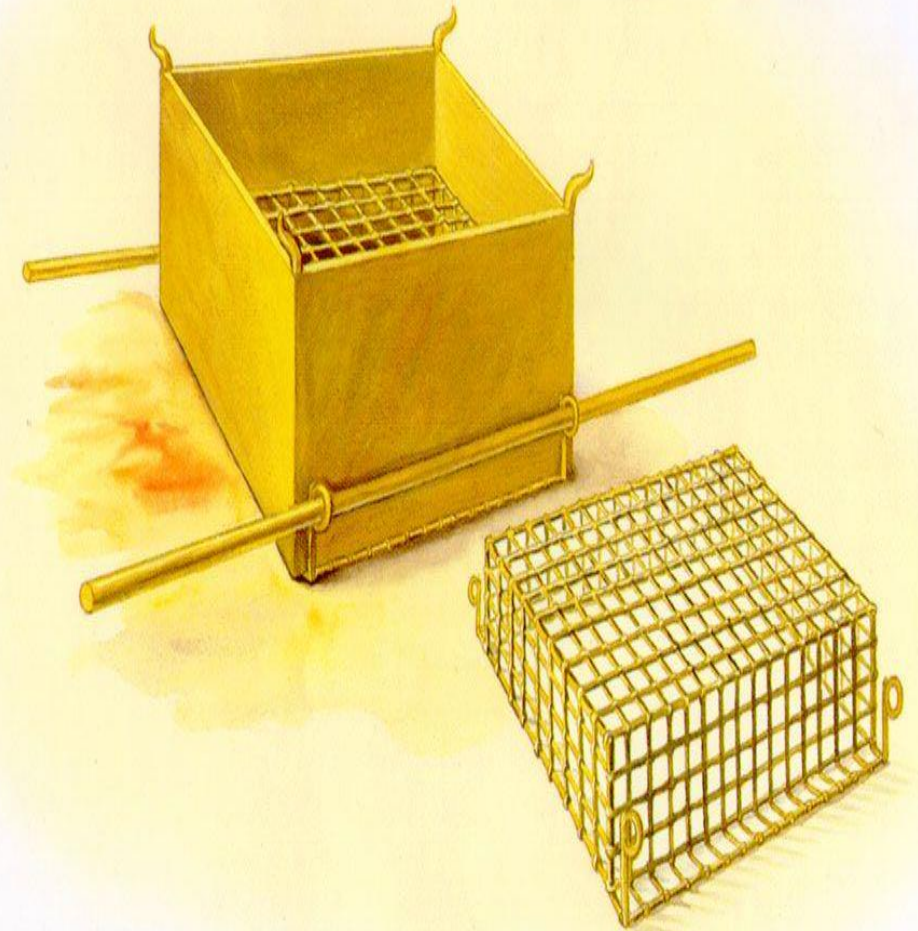
(see Daniel 7&8 , Zechariah 1:18-21, Psalms 89)

## 4 horns on the altar

Number 4: Symbolic of the Earth or human nature (Daniel 7:3; Matthew 13: Isaiah 11:12). Four directions, four seasons

Bronze Grating = Strong's  
#2677: half or middle this  
was to be at the exact same  
height as the mercy seat. God's mercy  
is mingled with the act of sacrifice. His  
Mercy shields us from death, and eternal  
separation

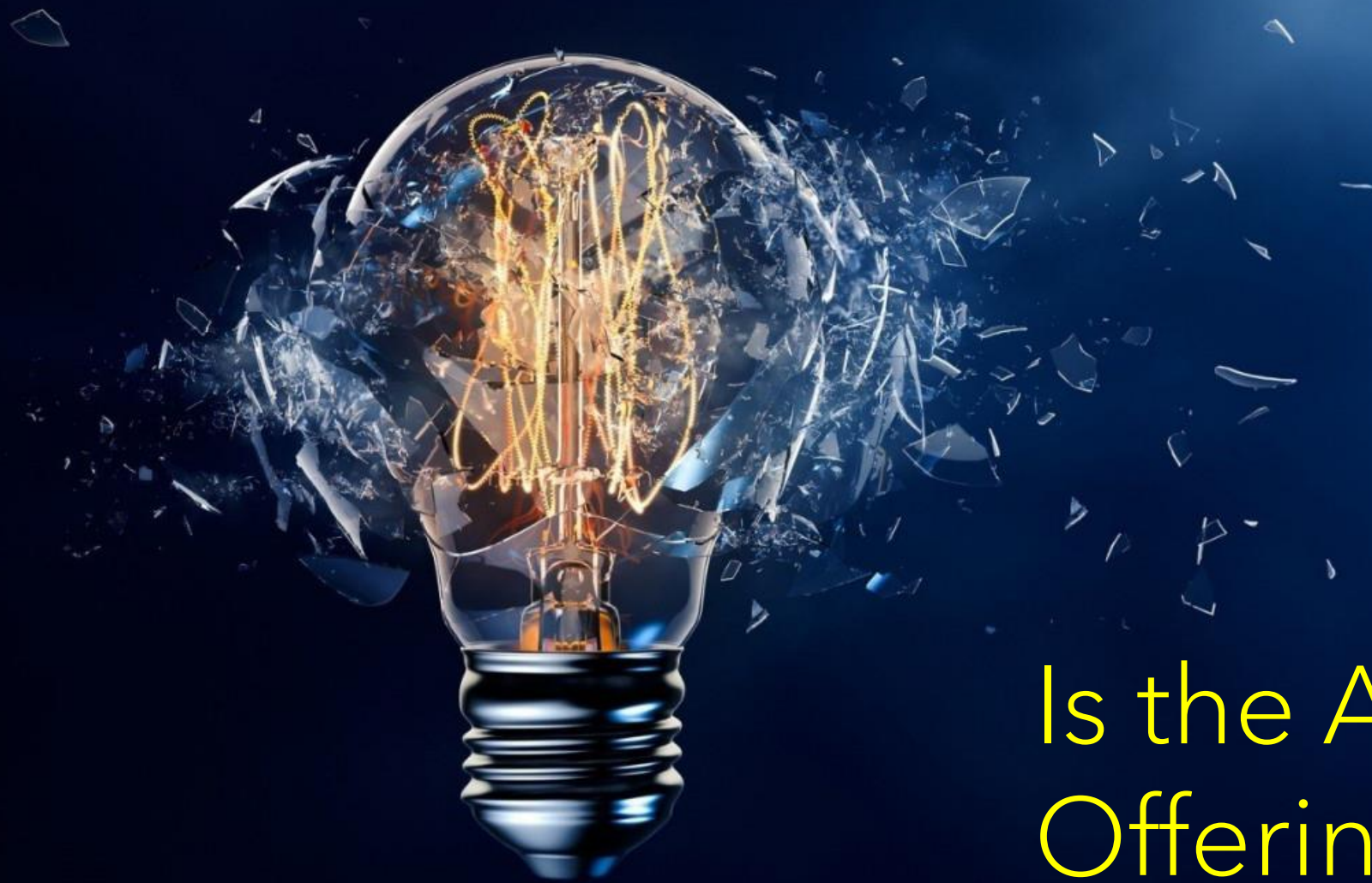

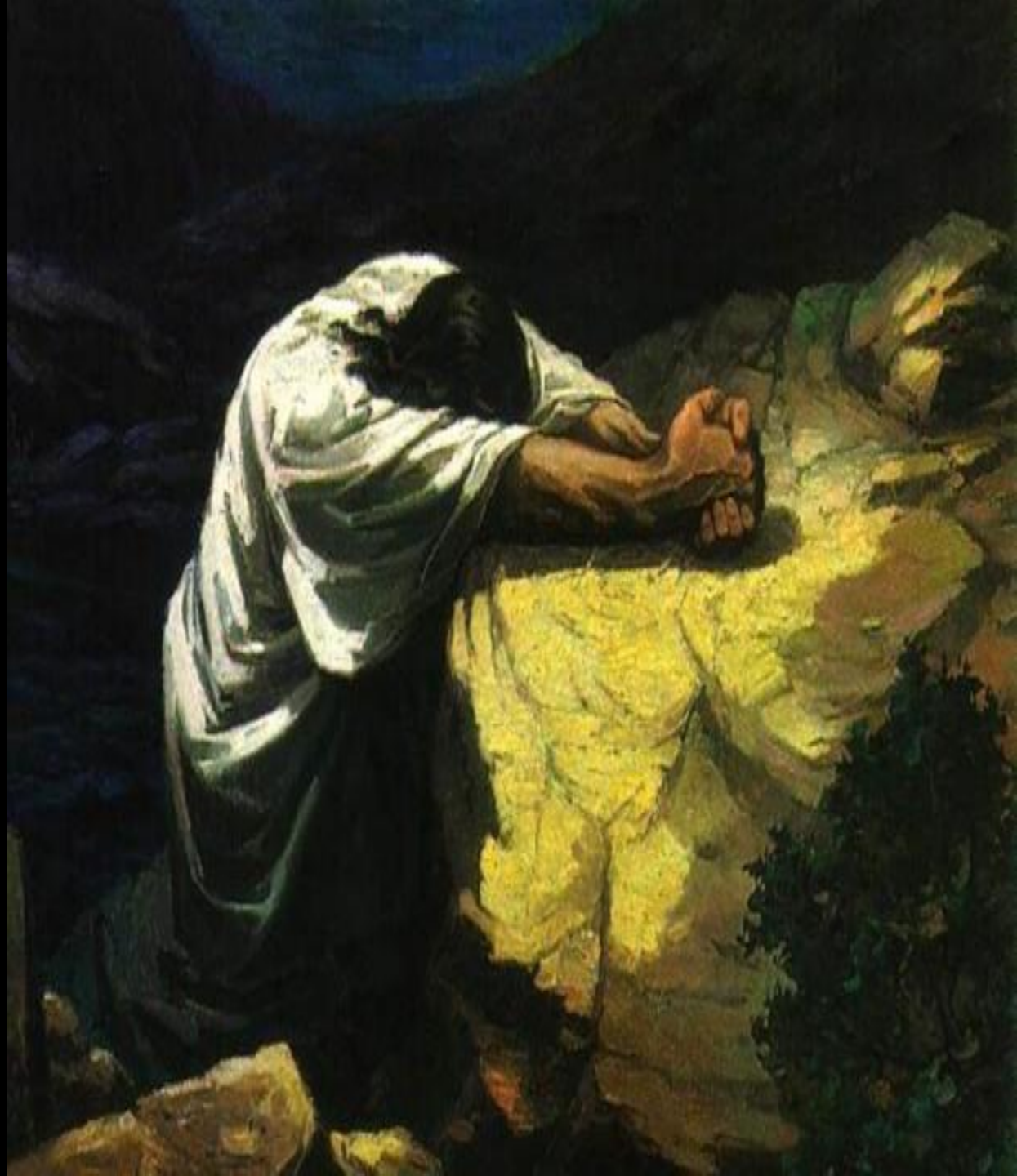

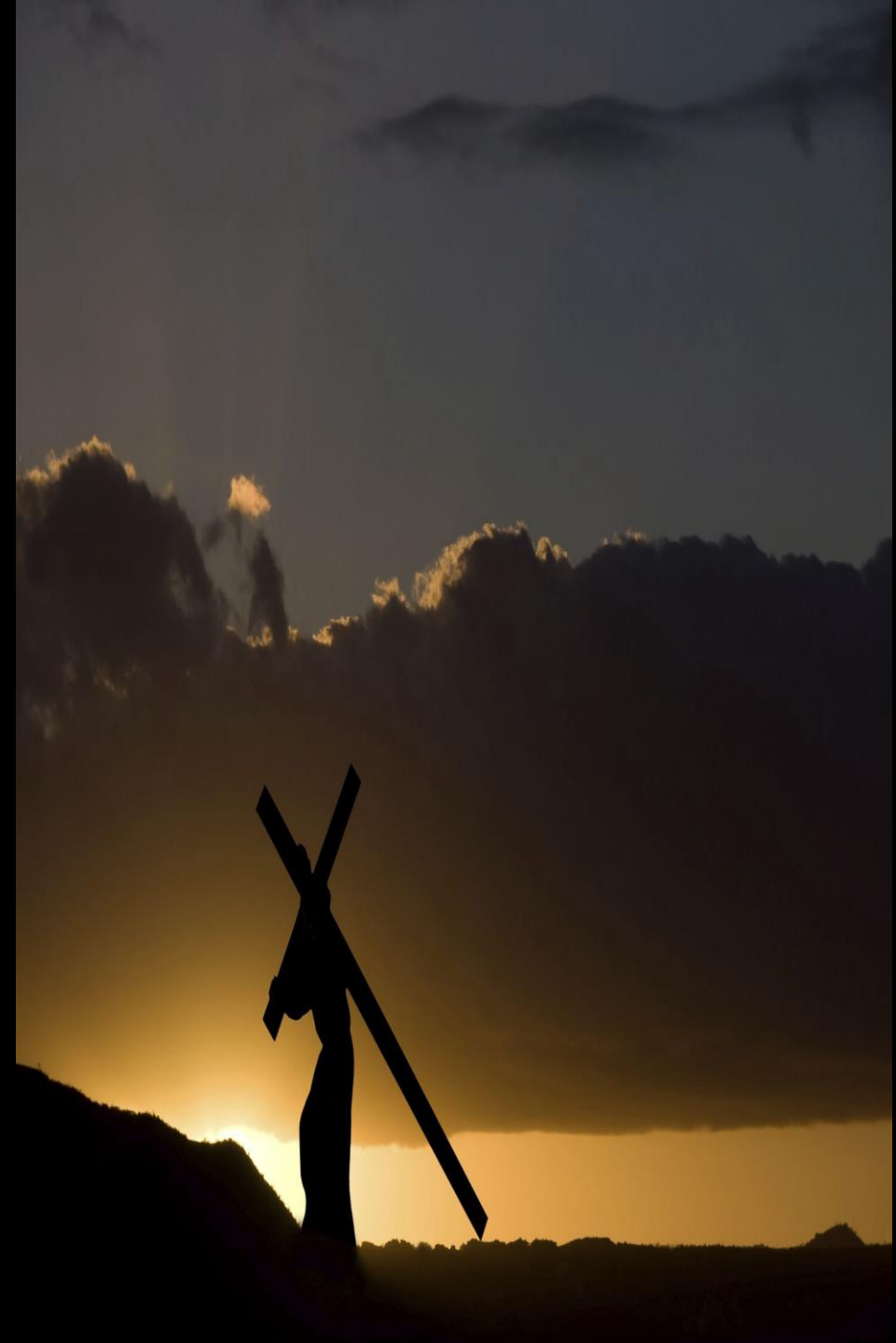
