Silverleaf POA Board Nomination Process 2024

According to the 2022 Bylaws posted on the Silverleaf website, all Board positions are up for election at the November 9, 2024 Annual Meeting since no meeting was held in 2023.

<u>Election of Officers</u>: Typically each Board of Director position will hold that office for a term of three years and follow the staggered schedule; however due to the current circumstances, in order to keep the staggered terms in-line with the bylaws three directors (President, Secretary and Member at Large) will have abbreviated terms:

For the 2024 elections:

- <u>President</u>: <u>Two</u> year term starting October 2024 with new election in October 2026
- <u>Vice President</u>: <u>Three</u> year term starting October 2024 with new election in October 2027
- <u>Treasurer</u>: <u>Three</u> year term starting October 2024 with new election in October 2027
- <u>Secretary</u>: <u>One</u> year term starting October 2024 with new election in October 2025
- <u>Member at Large</u>: <u>Two</u> year term starting in October 2024 with new election in October 2026.

There are two methods of nominating candidates:

1. Write-In Nomination:

A write-in nomination happens when members write down their nominees directly on the ballot. Property owners may submit their own names for candidacy. If the write-in candidate earns enough votes to win, at which point the winner will have the choice of either accepting the position or rejecting it.

2. Floor Nomination:

A floor nomination happens when an POA president calls for nominations during a meeting. Nominations don't need any second motions, though nominated candidates must still possess the right candidate qualifications.

Candidate Statement:

Candidates should make their candidacies and platforms known by completing a candidate statement. This statement should introduce the candidate's name and explain a bit of their background, their objectives and goals, the issues they want to address, and how they intend to achieve all of this.
