Internet Support:

PVFD has deployed a Starlink system to help local businesses and the community stay connected during the ongoing service outage.

Fuel Available:

Fuel is now available at both the gas station and the card lock next to it.

Card Payments Accepted:

The store, food trailer, and gas station are now accepting credit and debit cards. (we anticipate to connect the Pioneer Saloon tomorrow, as well as the Community Center)

Emergency Calls:

These locations also provide access for emergency phone calls.

You may use the Starlink system for essential needs such as:

Contacting family or loved ones to let them know you are safe

Making medical appointments or speaking with healthcare providers

Reaching employers or coworkers for job-related communication

Accessing online banking or managing urgent financial tasks

Any emergency-related communication

Please do not use the connection for:

Streaming movies or videos

Online gaming

Large downloads or recreational web browsing
