- Each student and each family who attends Classical Strands Community will be unique in their interests and abilities and personalities. The unifying factor in our community is the focus on Christ as the beginning and the end of all wisdom. It is not a distant reality for us, but rather a day to day walk with God. Families who attend CSC are not required to agree in every element of their Christian faith, but recognizing common ground will build a foundation of unity for the group and provide a powerful platform to grow in wisdom and understanding as we tackle the various subject matter throughout the student’s school experience.
 - Classes at every level will center around a Christian worldview, with emphasis being placed upon discovering God’s work in all of creation and thought.
 - Families must be willing to adhere to the attached Statement of Faith. We recognize there will be differences in details of how we walk out our faith, but on the big issues, unity will provide for more freedom in education and conversation.
 - In addition to our basic Statement of Faith, we follow scriptural principles, as laid out in Matthew 18, when conflict arises in the community. We aim to follow the principles in scripture and, with that goal in mind, we adhere to the principles found in Ken Sande’s book *The Peacemaker*.
