Epilogos 2019 Summary of Projects

- 3 houses were built for deserving families
 - 1 casita was built for a mother and her disabled child
 - 1 house was built for a family of six
 - 1 house was built for an elderly couple by volunteers from San José Villanueva
- 6 classrooms received much needed supplies through the Adopt a Classroom project
- 3 sessions of Big Friend/Little Friend were held
 - 15 younger students are mentored by 15 High School students in a program that helps improve self-esteem and teaches coping skills to the young students
- 2 workshops were held for High School students to help improve self-esteem and to offer them choices during and after High School

- Epilogos provided 54 Grade 1-9 scholarships
- 58 High School scholarships
- 5 special needs scholarships
- Funded the salary for the science teacher – this is the only science program in the area
- Epilogos partner St. Joseph’s Church in Strongsville, Ohio supported an additional 31 students from elementary through college age, and provided the funding for an assistant principal
- Multi-purpose area was completed at Las Dispensas School

- 19 organic cook stoves were purchased
- 35 water filters were distributed
- Sports equipment was provided to several villages
- Transportation and other expenses were covered for several students with special circumstances
