2020 was certainly a challenging year for everyone. But our staff worked tirelessly in SJV to provide help for those that needed it, and our donors continued to provide financial and spiritual support so that we could fulfill our mission:

To work **in solidarity** with the people of SJV to improve their quality of life while transforming the lives of volunteers.



### Education

Through all of the challenges of the year, school continued on! Administrators, teachers, students, and families rose to the challenge and managed to complete the school year in November. As in the US, in-person schooling was shut down in the spring. Many families in SJV have limited (or no) internet access, unreliable power, among other challenges. But they figured out solutions and persevered!

With a collaboration between Epilogos donors and St. Joseph's Catholic Church, in 2020 we provided scholarships to:

- 53 Elementary to Middle School Students
- 85 High School Students
- 7 Special Education Students
- 3 College Students
- Supported 3 Teacher's Salaries
