## **POLICE OFFICER**

The City of Genoa, IL (Pop. 5,200) is accepting applications for Entry Level Police Officer. The starting salary is \$52,820-\$56,053 as of May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 per collective bargaining agreement. The City also offers a generous benefit package. We utilize a 12-hour shift plan rotating on a twelve- week cycle that gives officers a three-day weekend every other week.

Applicants for original appointment must possess a valid driver's license, be United States citizens, meet the age requirements set forth in the Illinois State Statute 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6, and have earned a high school diploma or GED.

Applications are available from 5/4/21 to 5/25/21 at the Genoa Police Department Office, 333 E. First Street, Genoa, IL (Monday - Friday 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.) or on our website at [www.genoapd.com](http://www.genoapd.com). Applications must be returned by 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 25, 2021 to the Genoa Police Department Administrative Office.

All information must be submitted to be considered for this process. Any incomplete submittals will be rejected. The entire testing process may include review of completed packet, written test, oral interview, polygraph, psychological test, medical exam, and any other exams deemed necessary by the Police Commission. In addition, applicants should have no record of felony conviction or crime of moral turpitude.

We have scheduled the mandatory orientation and written test for 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 19, 2021 at the Genoa Police Department 333 East First Street, Genoa, IL 60135. A photo ID is required to enter the testing site. This is the only day this test will be held.
