DIRECTIONS;

From North: Take Hwy 99 South to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth Avenue, turn left (eastbound). The third stop light will be Golden State. Make a right on Golden State and then an immediate right on to North Front. Go approximately 2 blocks and make a right, cross the RR tracks, right on Broadway and enter through back gate.

From South: Take Hwy 99 North to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth Avenue, turn right (eastbound). Follow above directions.

From the Bay Area: Hwy 580 to 205 East towards Tracy/Stockton. Take I5 North and merge onto CA 120 towards Manteca/Sonora. Exit at Hwy 99 South (Modesto) and continue to Turlock.



Grounds and General Information – Trial will be outdoors on grass. Grounds open at 7am and close at 10pm. For late or early arrival information contact Susan Harris listed above. No designated grooming area however we ask that you keep grooming at least 20 feet from ringside. Electricity is available at a per day cost throughout the fairgrounds.

NEW FIRE CODE PARKING REQUIREMENTS

No parking within 20 feet of buildings. All Day of Parking will be in the midway (see map). If you are parked in an RV Spot or plugged into power you will be required to pay the RV fee, this includes day of exhibitors.

We want to make sure we are able to come back here so please adhere to these new requirements.



There is no parking near the barns. If you park by the barns the cost to you will be \$200.00 per day.



Overnight Parking for RVs at show site: Overnight RV parking will be available for **\$45 per night**, **TENT CAMPING AVAILABLE \$45 per night**. Pre-arrangement recommended. Some parking will have full hook-ups. Others will have electricity only. Dump station on site. No exit or entry 10 pm to 6 am. Overnight spaces may be assigned and should be reserved in advance. Un-reserved parking will be available at check in.

About Our Speaker:

Dr. Shelby was born and raised in central Missouri in a rural community. She earned her B.S. in Animal Sciences in May of 2013 from the University of Missouri. While there, she was a member of Sigma Alpha professional Agricultural Sorority, president of Pre-Vet Club, as well as competed on the National Livestock Judging Team her junior/senior year. She attended the College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Missouri and graduated in May 2017 with her DVM. She was very active in veterinary school, serving as Class President, President, and co-founder, of the Theriogenology Club (study of reproductive medicine), fundraising chair for the Missouri Mule Team, served as the National American Association of Bovine Practitioners representative for her college, and was involved in American Association of Equine Practitioners club.

Dr. Shelby's passion is comparative reproductive medicine (large and small animals). In her free time, she likes to ride horses, work with cattle, workout, read, and explore her new home state of California. She currently lives with her husband, who is an MD, and their pets (tortoiseshell cat, Pembroke Welsh Corgi, and Basset Hound). She is studying via the alternate training route to obtain her board certification in Theriogenology.

Kokopelli is a veterinarian run practice that houses the only small animal boarded theriogenologists (Dr Christensen) in the Northern California region. We focus on reproduction in all species, with a current primary focus on canine and equine reproductive medicine. We are in the process of building a general practice facility to help better serve all of our clients veterinary needs. We have advanced reproductive technology as well as a vast knowledge of reproductive medicine in animals which helps us provide top of the line care to all of our clients. Our goal is to help everyone achieve reproductive success.
