No class changes will be made once entries have closed. **Returned Checks** Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition the person writing the check will be reported to ASCA – No Exceptions. Delta ASF will add a \$30.00 Collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Anyone with a check returned must pay all future Delta ASF event fees in cash. Section 8: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or an ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned obedience trials. ...Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned obedience trials.

DIRECTIONS;
