Refunds & Class Changes— Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to closing of pre-entries. No refunds will be given for any entries received after pre-entry closing date; this includes emailed "day of show" entries. No class changes will be made once entries have closed.

Returned Checks: Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. In addition, the person writing the check will be reported to ASCA – No Exceptions. Delta ASF will add a \$35.00 Collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Anyone with a check returned must pay all future Delta ASF event fees in cash. NO Entry will be accepted from a dog, owner or handler disqualified from any ASCA Program or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

DIRECTIONS;

<u>From North</u>: Take Hwy 99 South to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth Avenue, turn left (eastbound). The third stop light will be Golden State. Make a right on Golden State and then an immediate right on to North Front. Go approximately 2 blocks and make a right, cross the RR tracks, right on Broadway and enter through back gate.

<u>From South:</u> Take Hwy 99 North to Turlock. Exit Fulkerth Avenue, turn right (eastbound). Follow above directions. <u>From the Bay Area:</u> Hwy 580 to 205 East towards Tracy/Stockton. Take I5 North and merge onto CA 120 towards Manteca/Sonora. Exit at Hwy 99 South (Modesto) and continue to Turlock.

Grounds and General Information:

- Show will be outdoors on grass.
- Grounds open at 7am and close at 10pm. For late or early arrival information contact the show coordinator listed above.
- No designated grooming area however we ask that you keep grooming at least 20 feet from ringside.
- Electricity is available at the rate of \$50 per day throughout the fairgrounds with preference given to overnight RV accommodation. Please notify the show coordinator prior to the show if you would like to reserve electricity.
- No dog may enter the show ring or be given an armband without a completed entry form and all show fees paid in full.
- Pre-entries with missing/inaccurate information or missing/inaccurate payment will not be added to the judges' books until all information and/or payment is received. Be sure to read your entry and the flyer carefully to avoid delay.
- All minors must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times while on the show grounds.
- Animals must have adequate shade and water and may not be left unattended while on the show grounds.

PLEASE READ THE NEW FIRE CODE PARKING REQUIREMENTS BELOW


PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE NEW FIRE-CODE PARKING REQUIREMENTS. DAY OF SHOW PARKING IS ON THE MAP BELOW.

If you are parked in an RV spot you will need to pay for that spot. There is absolutely no parking near the barns. If you are parked by the barns the cost

to you will be \$200.00 per day. NEW FIRE CODE PARKING REQUIREMENTS

No parking within 20 feet of buildings. All Day of Parking will be in the midway (see map). If you are parked in an RV Spot or plugged into power you will be required to pay the RV fee, this includes day of exhibitors.

We want to make sure we can come back here so please adhere to these new requirements.



Overnight Parking for RVs at show site: Overnight RV parking will be available for \$50 per day, TENT CAMPING AVAILABLE \$50 per day. Showers are only available at the March/April show Prearrangement recommended. Some parking will have full hook-ups. Others will have electricity only. Dump station on site. No exit or entry 10 pm to 6 am. Overnight spaces will be assigned and should be reserved in advance. Un-reserved overnight parking may be available at check in but not guaranteed.
