

## **Mountain Top Amateur Radio Meeting - Minutes**

September 1, 2020, 7:00 pm Online Zoom session

#### I. Welcome

Tracy, WM6T, opened the Zoom session shortly before 7:00 pm, we had 34 members attending. Jodi and Tracy built the attendee list as folks checked in.

The meeting began officially by President Vic, KK6WKI, at 7:06 pm.

#### II. Introductions

A local ham radio operator recently became a silent key. Randy Fear, KC6JTN. Tracy, WM6T gave us a quick biography starting with his introduction to Randy in 2006 as the Big Bear ECS captain. He was big in building repeaters and was responsible for most of those surrounding the Big Bear Valley. Randy also managed the Solar Observatory on the north shore and was employed by the University of Delaware to maintain it. In recent years, Randy was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease. He was a great friend and mentor and will be greatly missed. We observed a moment of silence in honor of his passing.

Vic, KK6WKI, welcomed the group, we had 40 and 42 attendees at the last 2 virtual monthly club sessions. Training continues with our virtual Zoom sessions covering a variety of topics and virtual ham shack visits. Our sessions are now only on Thursdays.
