9/13/25	<u>BOOSTER VACCINATION (4 weeks prior to delivery)</u>
9/17/25	<u>FINAL ENTRY DEADLINE</u> DO NOT MISS DEADLINE ~ FULL PAYMENT REQUIRED All entry forms must be fully completed - NO EXCEPTIONS BVD negative test information due

10/10/25	<u>DELIVERY OF BULLS TO TEST FACILITY</u> Bulls will not be accepted unless all conditions of acceptance have been met. Delivery weight of bulls must be at least 650 pounds . Washington Bulls need a C.O.P. (Certificate of Permit or Haul Slip). All out of state bulls need health certificates and brand inspection papers on intake day. ALL REQUIRED PAPERWORK IS DUE AT DELIVERY A BRAND INSPECTION IS REQ. BEFORE ANY BULL CAN BE REMOVED FROM THE BULL TEST SITE. OUT OF STATE CONSIGNORS IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ARRANGING INSPECTION AND FEES. ** Two week warm-up period, prior to on-test weights

You will be required to provide documents of vaccination protocol, additionally we can not stress enough the importance of weaning your bull calves at least 45 days prior to delivery to the feedlot. Calves properly vaccinated and timely weaned have a much greater probability of staying healthy during the test period.

All consignors will NEED to bring trailers to the sale! You are responsible for the transportation of your own no sale bulls and, if at all possible, assist with deliveries of sold bulls.

Any No Sales bulls not removed from the sales facility will be assessed a non removal fee paid to the WBA of 75.00 per bull in addition to a daily feed charge to be paid by you directly to bonina.

Consignors with bulls requiring treatment with medications while on the test will be informed and sent an outlying invoice to be paid directly to the WBA at the end of each applicable month.
