

Consignor Timeline & Expectations 2021/22
From final entry to Sale Date
REVISED

- Aug 31** **Wean calves AT LEAST 45 days prior to delivery required.**
- Place on mineral program, treat for coccidiosis at the ranch
- Sept 17 Booster vaccination (4 weeks before delivery)
Complete tests for genetic defects and parentage verification
- Sept 17** **Final entry deadline**
- **DO NOT MISS THIS DEADLINE! Full payment required.**
 - All entry forms must be fully completed - **NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - BVD Negative test information due
- Oct 1 All required paperwork submitted for final acceptance and unloading of bulls at
The test facility.
- Oct 8 Delivery of bulls to test facility. Bulls will not be accepted unless they have met all the conditions
of entry. Delivery weights of bulls should be at least 650 lbs. Washington bulls need a C.O.P.
(Certificate of Permit or Haul Slip). All out of state bulls need Health Certificate and Brand
Inspection Papers. A brand inspection is required before any bull can be removed from the Bull
Test site. The consignor is responsible for arranging the inspection and paying the fees.
- Oct 29 On Test Weights
- Nov 1 Signed hard copy of Registration papers and 205-day weights due. Corrections of Information or
missing information due. **HARD DEADLINE**
- Dec 27 Mid-test weights and lice treatment
- Dec 27** Footnotes/comments for sale catalog due to sale Coordinator **HARD DEADLINE**
- Jan 7 All Ads, corrections, changes or additions to sale catalog due. **DROP DEAD DEADLINE!!**
- *Feb 8 Ultrasound (tentative)
- *Feb 10-11 Semen test (tentative)
- Feb 16 Catalog to be finalized and mailed by Sales Coordinator
- Feb 26 Off Test weights (120-days)
- Late Feb.? (Date not yet determined) Videotaping of Bulls (after clipped)
- Feb 28-Mar 4 Clip (tentative)
- Mar 2 Semen retest (tentative) Final Sifting of Bulls
- Mar 15 Haul bulls to Bonina Facility

Consignor's meeting at 9:00 am. Bull Sale at 12:30 pm

You will be required to provide documentation of vaccination protocol, additionally we can't stress enough the importance of weaning your bull calves at least 45 days prior to delivery to the feedlot. Calves properly vaccinated and timely weaned have a much greater probability of staying healthy during the test period.

All Consignors need to bring their trailers to the sale! YOU are responsible for getting your no-sale bulls' home and, if at all possible, assist with delivery of sold bulls. Any No sale bulls not removed from Bonina Sale Facility will be assessed a "non-removal" fee paid to WBA of \$75.00 per bull in addition to a daily feed charge to be paid by you to Bonina.

Consignors with bulls requiring treatment and medication while on test will be informed and sent an outlined invoice to be paid directly to WBA at the end of each applicable month.

This is a change from prior years and will aide in our ability to get your sales check sent to you in a timelier manner.
