Steve Fisher is a graduate of York High School class of 1981. The Fisher family has had students at York since the school opened in 1954. During his time as a student, he participated in Football, Soccer, Track, and was very involved in the Drama department.

Steve earned a Bachelor of Science in mathematics degree at Christopher Newport University in 1993 and, since that time, has been a long-time math instructor working in the State of Virginia. He worked for the City of Hampton for 9 years spending time at Spratley Middle and Kecoughtan High, as well as Newport News for a summer school session at Woodside High School.

Steve began teaching math at York High school in 2003 and has instructed in almost every level of math during this career, spanning pre-Algebra to Calculus.
