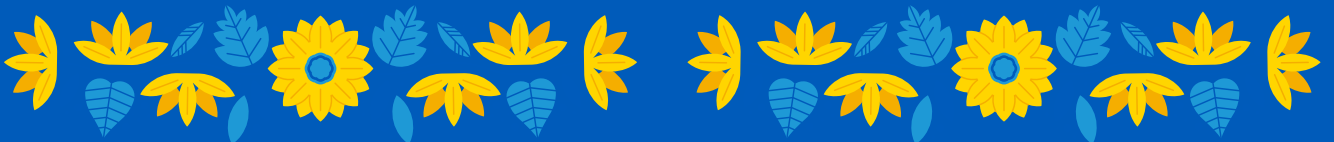

Dear EKS Families, Parents, Students, Faculty, Staff and Friends,

Welcome and thank you for attending our very first EKS Gala Concert and spending this weekend with us to celebrate our 8th year at EKS!

French composer Hector Berlioz once said, "Love cannot express the idea of music, while music may give an idea of love." This is exactly why we are here this weekend - to share our love for music, and to express our passion through nurturing the next generation of musicians, both young and old.

EKS students have accomplished so much in many ways since last summer. 8 students received the EKS Ensemble Scholarship. 2 EKS students received prize and honorable mention in the Massachusetts Judged Festival. This year, we have the biggest and one of our best faculty team EKS have ever assembled. Along the way, we also broke a few EKS records: 37 students participated in the RCM exam and 11 students received the highest honor in their respective disciplines and levels; 94 students successfully completed our beloved annual 28-days practice challenge in March etc.

The world has definitely changed in many ways in the past two years. Just the past year, we have seen many unthinkable and injustice acts happening in the world and people in our own country have lost their love ones in a horrific act just a few weeks ago in Texas. Belarusian pianist, Maya Irgalina, said, "When the words fail, there is music left ...and music united us." Music is a strong weapon of humanity. It is emotional and uniting. Individuals simply become connected by sitting together and sharing music with one another. I would like to acknowledge and express my heartfelt gratitude for all the faculty and staff for their tireless dedication and commitment to our students and their families. Last but not least, a huge thank you to all the parents for putting your trust and confidence in us and your countless support and encouragement to your children in their music learning endeavor. EKS is not just a music school where you send your children or yourself to come for a weekly lesson. It is a community. It is a place we all feel safe learning and growing together.

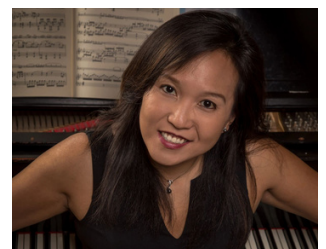

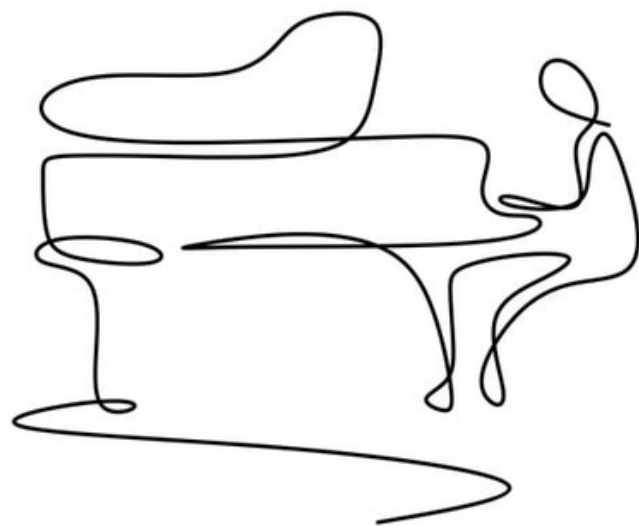

Since 2014 (Except 2020-2021 due to COVID) we have offered numerous scholarships to woodwinds, guitar, strings, voice and piano students in taking ensemble lessons and workshops at and outside EKS Music School. Fifth Anniversary: Ms. Jen Pearl

"Five years ago, I was at a point in my life when I needed and wanted to get into teaching again. On a whim, I called around to different music schools on the South Shore leaving messages. Soon after, I got a return call from Ellyses that EKS needed a voice teacher that Fall and after an interview and a teaching trial lesson with a student, I happily joined the faculty at EKS! It was totally meant to be, the timing was just right!

I have learned and grown so much as a teacher at EKS the last five years. What I love most about EKS is that EKS students' families and the school are deeply committed to the musical education of their children, and as a teacher, I really appreciate that. It's tough when society doesn't always see music education as a priority in a child's education. Furthermore, there is a lot of societal pressure particularly from the rise in popularity of shows like "The Voice" and "Americas Got Talent," for kids to be a "star". I feel really strongly that every child has the potential to develop a beautiful voice, regardless of "natural talent."

I have been really encouraged that EKS fully supports my approach to teaching which is not only to develop the voice of my students, but to help develop the character through the study of the Italian bel canto method of singing and the Classical repertoire (I also use a lot of international folk songs, which are excellent and fun for any age to sing). The quality of thinking that one develops working on music and singing, naturally influences the way one thinks throughout life, whether in school, work, or every day social interaction. What guides my teaching is the strong belief that we are creating better and happier citizens when we are teaching children and young adults to sing!

In my first year at EKS, I taught a group voice class out of which two of the students continued on to study privately with me and still do today. To watch them vocally develop and just grow up from young children to young adults has been a true joy and quite rewarding as a teacher. I have also really enjoyed working with the adult students at EKS and our work on music together has often turned into friendships and musical collaborations. I look forward to continuing to teach and see many more students grow and find the joy of singing."

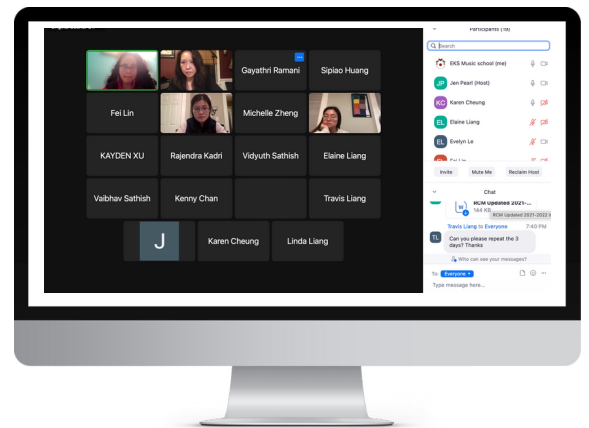

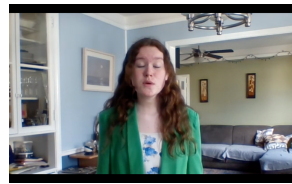
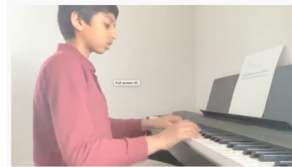
