

In-Person vs. Online Lesson

Voice Lesson

 All voice lessons, unfortunately, will remind ONLINE until further notice due to the concerns of transmission through emission of aerosols, which is affected by loudness of vocalization and which can travel from 15-30 feet and stay on the wall in the studio.

REOPENING POLICY & GUIDELINES

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING POLICY CHANGE:

- Students and their immediate family must be COVID-19 symptom-free for 14 days
 before the lesson. This includes cough, fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing,
 flu-like symptoms, gastrointestinal upset, a loss of taste or smell, or red/purple
 fingers or toes. If you are not feeling well, please stay home.
- If a student or any member of their immediate family tests positive, or has come in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19, the school must be notified ASAP.
- Any lessons cancelled due to the above reasons will be conducted in an online format.
- Mask/face covering is required for entry/exit of the school and the duration of lesson.
- Upon entry, student is required to sanitize their hands and his/her temperature will
 be taken by the instructor using a touch-less thermometer. Anyone with a
 temperature higher than 99F will be excused from the studio and sent home
 immediately. Lessons will not be made up in such circumstances.
- The waiting area at EKS will be temporarily closed.
 - Please wait outside the school until your instructor comes out and picks you or your children up at lesson time.
 - Students 6 year-old of above will be dropped off ONLY.
 - Only **ONE** parent can accompany student 5 year-old or under and sit at a designated area in the studio.
 - No sibling is allowed to come in the school. If the sibling is scheduled to have lesson of his/her own, please only come to the school at their lesson time and observe the above same safety measures.
 - Instructor will walk the student to the door after each lesson and make sure they sanitizer their hands before they leave the school parameter.
- To minimize exposure, the bathroom will only be opened to on-site faculty and staff to prevent possible spread. **Please plan accordingly.** If a student desperately needs to use the bathroom for any diarrhetic reason, we will terminate the lesson at once and send the student home for medical assistance after his/her use of the bathroom. Our staff will disinfect and sanitize the bathroom immediately. Unfinished lesson time will not be made up in such circumstances.
- All shared instruments, especially piano and bench, will be disinfected by the instructor at the beginning and end of each lesson.
- Instructors will teach from a separate instrument and distance while demonstrating proper technique and point to music with a laser pointer.
- Students should only bring limited belongings to school such as music books, a personal pencil (for taking notes and annotating their own scores) and/or a personal water bottle. No food and beverage other than water is allowed.
- To ensure the safety of the staff, all payment will be done electronically through your credit card on file. We will not be accepting cash or checks at the moment.
