- Stylus
- 3mm Red tool
- 4mm mauve tool
- 5mm light blue tool
- 6mm orange tool
- 8mm Pink
- 9mm Dark Green
- 10mm Dark Blue
- 12mm Green
- 15mm Yellow

This pattern was created using our basic 10pc tool set but can also be done with our Superset

Coffee at Bondi



For this design we are using

Happy Dotting Company 10-piece basic dotting tool set 5' x 5' Black card stock
Happy Dotting Company 8 segment stencil
Generals White chalk pencil




Paint colours used in this design

1	Dk Blue 11mm	Pearl White
Make o	enter dot

2	Red 3mm	Tangerine
Make 8 dots on guidelines

3	Mauve 4mm	Bondi Blue
Make 8 dots out and between from tangerine		




Step#	Tool used	Paint colour used
4	Lge Stylus	Pearl White
Make 2 dots out from Tangerine		





Resist pressing your tools down hard - only the paint should make contact with the surface



Make 2 dots out side of the last coffee dots





Walk the dots around the outer edge of last coffee dots

Make 8 dots out from dark teal





15	Red 3mm	Bondi Blue


Make 2 dots side by side out from dark teal

Make 8 dots out from bondi blue		



Make 8 dots out from pearl white		



Let this first layer dry overnight then rub away chalk pencil marks with a damp ear bud cleaner





Top Dots



Make a dot on top of the pearl white center dot





Allow your mandala to dry thoroughly e.g. overnight
You then have the option to spray with a gloss sealer available from art supply shops
This size pattern also works well on our Art Stone Mold #2
