Ontario Tactical Advisory Board Range Practice with Direct Action Combat Performance

This range practice will provide officers the opportunity to integrate their service pistol and carbine rifle while receiving exposure to the Marathon Target System. The MTS is a training tool designed to challenge and enhance tactical marksmanship abilities.

Direct Action will provide live-fire drills specifically designed to produce threat discrimination, malfunction drills under duress, and positional / transitional drills at various distances. The robot targets will act as fleeing subjects running towards the officers while armed with knife or gun. The robots will test the tactical officer with unpredictable movement patterns and speeds.

WHO: Tactical officers interested in training (maximum of 20 registered spots).

WHAT: Range practice with pistol and long gun.

WHERE: OPP Range – UHTOFF Burnside Line Orillia.

WHEN: Tuesday 17 May, 2022. 8am to 12pm.

WHY: To experience to a training tool that will amplify your tactical shooting pedigree.

FEE: \$75 per officer. *Registration through OTAB website.

Officer requirements:

Pistol and carbine rifle. Full tactical load-out less helmet. Baseball cap. Eye protection and hearing protection. Optional kit: Knee pads and elbow pads.

Minimum round count: 300 rounds of carbine ammunition. 200 rounds of pistol ammunition. *Due to the range limitations; .223 / 5.56mm, 9mm and .40 calibre ONLY.

*NO shotgun, 300 blackout, .308, or .338 calibre rounds will be utilized for this practice.

Direct Action will provide:

Range conduct and overall safety. Instruction and coaching. Additional targets and range kit.

Marathon Targets will provide:

2-4 Robot target systems, instruction and system management.
