Course Prerequisites

Successful candidates will leave the course with the **Knowledge, Skills and Abilities** to prepare and present quality, defensible operational plans. They will also be able to confidently deliver a briefing, plan or set of orders and assign tasks as part of the plan. Candidates will be exposed to scenarios such as major events, drug raids, barricaded persons, take-downs and other domestic operations. Local area venues will be used for scenarios allowing planning syndicates to conduct real-time reces and develop plans based on actual locations.
