Parts of a Friendly Letter:


*<u>Greeting/Salutation</u>– Usually begins with Dear ______ and ends with a comma.

*<u>Body</u>– This is the main text, which includes the message or information you are writing in your letter.

*<u>Closing</u>– In the closing the first word is capitalized and you put a comma after the last word. This is a short expression on a single line. Some examples of closing are: Sincerely, Your friend, Love

*<u>Signature Line</u>- This is your name and goes under the closing.

*<u>Postscript</u>– If your letter contains a postscript, begin it with "P.S." and end it with your initials.
