Water Quality – 15 Minutes – Frank

Of note from the report: see comment on Federal St Dam. They are waiting to hear from the dam manu facturer and the installer (two separate entities). Current water flow is allegedly steady and is not worsening

Wyo Co is planning on applying for a grant for the planning piece of the dredging project which requires tourism and financial assessments and also the villages/towns to sign on for the plan

As of 7/7 the VoP has already signed on and the ToP and ToCastile just have to meet to sign on but it will move forward most likely with those entities

LED flares made 478\$ for CLEAN (16\$ a pair plus tax from Wegmans) but may be available direct from supplier

SLA needs to think through the flare situation (continue to sell the kind we are selling, sell both kinds, try to develop partnership with Wegmans, Burts, Elitsac, etc.)
