Water Quality – Frank Bright

- See attached report
- Weeds are extremely prevalent this year because of clear water, mild winter, and mild spring, most prevalent in shallow areas where sun can reach sediment areas
- A few complaints have come in we are setting up a subcommittee looking into harvesting of lake weeds
 - Lots of prior information about this but asking for help as to what the SLA would like this committee to do
 - Would be nice to develop a long term solution, possible suggestions include weed harvesting/cutter, algaecide, Skaneatlas has a team of divers that pluck weeds because they are water supply for Syracuse



- Chataqua harvests weeds and has a 3 million dollar operating budget and they own all their own equipment
 - Chataqua pulls them out of the lake after cutting
- Going to be a large number to do anything of significance to combat weed problems
- Who should be on this committee? People that it impacts need volunteers
- Directions on how to make benthic mats on SLWQ websites need to use perforated fabrics
 - DEC effective 4-5 years ago requires permit for weed mats
- Ron Norton noticed blue-gray water at North end it is latex paint we found a roller and pain on a rock and came back as latex paint
- All municipal meetings must be published in the Perry Herald always scan the Perry Herald and share with leadership of SLA/WQ – if you see something in the Herald contact Kelly or Frank
 - No action on Emmerling farm issue brought up at last meeting
- Drinking water source protection program is a program to protect the integrity of drinking water
 - Water comes from lake gets processed at water treatment plant to become potable and then sent out to homes
 - Ron and Frank were able to direct attention to all users within the watershed including farms and all Silver Lake communities
- Canandaigua forum: large algae blooms in Canandaigua we have not had a big one in a while
- Perry Herald: report about dredging project being put forward to Claudia Tenney as the planning board put it in front of Congresswoman Tenney – go to congressional website link and send a message to her in favor of dredging and thank her for shepharding this proposal along
 - Link is in the WQ report
 - No devotion of funds yet but she was looking for large budget items in Wyo Co and dredging is #1
- Biodigester discussed in the Perry Herald it is the bioreactor that was discussed at the last meeting
 - Misconception was that it was grant funded
- CSLAP report is interactive on the website can compare lakes across the state for water quality
- Monarch butterfly Kelly working with folks in the SLI and Doug Kelly at Letchworth for plantings
- Golf tournament is coming along record number of teams with two slots left
 - Still need raffle baskets and donations



- Todd Shuskey has been busy with his students out on the lake catching fish specimens and doing other sampling that is then sent to the DEC for processing
- Water levels and drought monitors online use the links
- Temperature array is working well
