## Water Quality - 15 Minutes - Frank Bright

see attached report
-For several months have been trying to touch base with Castile town board to learn about sewer system around the lake to try to get on their radar. This has been spearheaded by Lee Loomis
-Coffer Dam is being installed on/around September 19th to repair leaking dam gates. Definite date to be set soon and will be widely circulated. Coffer dam will be in place long enough to dewater the entire outlet so that they can service the seals on the dam. Expected to go down about 1 " with this process
-CSLAP is almost done for the season - report for last year was received. It has a running average of all of the chemistry of the lake. Interesting point is that over the past decade the dissolved phosphorous in the lake has been progressively dropping (phosphorous is primary nutrient that feeds lake weeds/plants that are a nuissance).
-Combination of farmers all having concrete retention ponds now so that it is only spread at the proper times of the year which limits run off from the farms
-Also 3,000 plants around the lake strategically planted
-Silver Lake experience went well and Todd's presentation was well received
-2023 golf tournament will remain in the morning not moved to the afternoon date is July 22nd 2023 a weekend earlier
-Japanese knotweed second spraying completed - most that was easily accessible has been very successful. The plants immediately near the water have not been affected as much. Cost was about half of original quote because Silver Lake Country Club did not want to participate
-FOLA mtg is October 22nd at Moonwinks in Cuba NY
-Planting to be scheduled at tentative site at North End of Sherman Rd the Devola's property - plan is a single day event on October 14th at 9 am
