This award was established in 1997 to honor those property owners that practice environmentally sound property management. The HOD award will be presented at the Annual meeting of the SLA on Saturday, August 10th at 9am at The Club at Silver Lake.

The winner of the HOD award for 2018 was Bonnie and Frank Bright of Lakeside Avenue, Sutton Tract. Along with receiving a "Cracked Ice" style first place trophy their names were added to a plaque that is displayed at Silver Lake Marine.
