a message from our pastor

Advent is upon us! The season of preparation - anticipation - hope. The Hanging of the Greens has been accomplished and we are off to the races. First some house keeping items.

We will gather on Christmas Eve at 5:00 p.m. for our Candlelight service. There was much conversation and research done here. This is the closest thing to consensus.

While we will NOT have midweek services this year, but mark your calendars for NEXT year. Holden Evening Prayer (Marty Haugen) makes a wonderful midweek service! I really was trying to make it a year without major changes. It's going to be close.

And speaking of services - we are now using Setting 2 (written by Marty Haugen) and will stay with it through the season of Epiphany. Then as we begin our Lenten journey we will switch to Setting 5 (the old chant setting from SBH). Midweek services during Lent will feature a Haugen setting you probably don't know, but will absolutely love. "Unfailing Light" is a simply gorgeous Vespers service. We will be meeting in the early evening. Isn't change invigorating?

OK.... back to the regularly scheduled column about preparation - anticipation and hope! We are not "preparing" for Jesus' birth - that has already occurred. We look forward to a second coming. And we prepare for a renewal - rebirth - rekindling of Jesus' presence among us now. As we remember - renew - recommit, it is helpful to keep a couple of historical realities in mind.

The first Advent occurred under less than ideal circumstances. We dress it up for the sake of pageants, but all was not well. Rome was an occupying force. People were suspicious and distrustful. There was tremendous economic disparity, great uncertainty, a large measure of despair. And Jesus came... into all of that. Jesus came in spite of all that. Jesus came to balance that. That first Advent did not magically change the world, but the world would never be the same.

It is far too easy to slide into cheap cynicism when looking at the world which God so loves! We become dismissive and dejected. And yet Christ is present. He does not take away the chaos, but serves as a touch-point within the chaos. He does not magically take away hate, but offers himself as love within the hate. Despair is always an option, but Christ is hope in the midst of despair. Where is our focus?

When we gather on Saturday or Sunday or Wednesday (when scheduled) - our focus is upon worshiping the God we see revealed most clearly, profoundly and perfectly within the risen, living and present Christ. As we move into and through another Advent season, let us recommit our focus to the God focused upon us... who comes to us.... who abides with us.

Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.

We will need volunteers to supply:


- 2 crockpots of mashed potatoes (recipes provided; can be made the day before)
