# a message from our pastor

A brief "end of Summer" word about Stewardship. Well, maybe a couple of words about Stewardship. The first is "thank you." This symbolic act helps to underscore the fact that we gift of our time, talent and treasure. We return a portion of all that is first given to us. More than simply giving money (important though that is), we return grain and wine which God turns into a feast for us. God takes our gifts and creates a life giving meal! The gifts of God, returned to God, continue still to be a blessing and source of life and strength!

William How wrote the words many years ago - sometime in the 19<sup>th</sup> century - and they are still true today:

We give thee but thine own, whate'er the gift may be; all that we have is thine alone, a trust O Lord, from thee.

May we thy bounties thus as stewards true receive, and gladly, as thou blessest us, to thee our first-fruits give.
