

<u>REMINDERS</u>: Speed Limit on Campground Roads is 5 miles per hour. Please obey all posted signs.

No bonfires. Fires allowed only in Fireplaces and Grills. Burning of leaves, paper & clean trash is acceptable, but no foodstuff, garbage, or diapers.

No cutting of Mountain Laurel. No cutting of trees without signed approval by the Grounds Director. Wood is for sale at the store.

Children under 16 years of age and non-swimmers must be with an adult in the pool area. Anyone with long hair must have it braided or tied back while in pool. Long hair clogs the filters. No food or glass allowed in the fenced in pool area.

Quiet time is from 11:00 pm. to 8:00 am. Children 12 and younger must be with their parents after dusk and for the remainder of the night. Teenagers 13-17 years of age must be with parents from quiet time on.

No one is allowed in the playground after dark. No bicycles on walkways or grass areas. Bicyclers should use caution on roads and observe the 5 Speed limit. NO riding after dark. Helmets must be worn per State Law. You are responsible for bringing your trash to dumpsters. On Holiday weekends there is trash pickup on Saturday at 6 pm & Sundays at 3 pm.

Pets must be on a hand held leash at all times when walking or tied up when on site. Loose dogs will receive one written warning for first offense from the camp managers. The second offense the dog will be banned from the campground for the remainder of the season. We have to make sure our walkers are safe from dogs jumping on them and getting bitten. Pets must not be left alone on site. A barking dog is an unpleasant neighbor and must be kept quiet. Too many complaints may result in the dog being banned from the campground for the remainder of the season. All dog droppings need to be picked up and properly disposed of. There are container and bags places around the campground. In order to bring your dog with you camping, you must provide a copy of a current rabies certificate yearly to the store manager.

Trespassing or cutting through sites is not permitted. Please use walkways and roads. Thank You
