


From the East:

Take I-64 (40/61) across the Daniel Boone Bridge (Missouri River). Continue approximately 8 miles to Lake St. Louis Blvd., at the top of the ramp turn left, the NEC is about 1.5 miles on the left-hand side.

Or From The West:

Take I-70 Northeast to the 40/61 exit. Go east to the Lake St. Louis Blvd. Exit (about 1 mile). At the top of the ramp, go left (southeast). The NEC is 1.5 miles on the left-hand side.

General Information

SHOW OFFICE: Located off the main lobby. The show office will open Thursday morning and remain open until approximately 8 p.m. The show office will open each day of the show 30 minutes before the start of classes and will close after the end of the show each day.

ENTRIES CLOSE: FEBRUARY 25th, 2026. All entries must be made online at www.ringsideproductionsllc.com. All entries made at the show, regardless of pre-entry, will be charged post entry fees of \$20/class.

Pay by credit card or check! (No fee if paying by check)**

Entries will only be considered complete if the following are fulfilled when entering:

- A. All Membership cards must be current. No need to send copies.
- B. Registration Transfers must be complete. No need to send copies of Registration papers.

THERE WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL \$25.00 CHARGE FOR EACH INCOMPLETE ENTRY.

Entries lacking any of the above-mentioned will be considered incomplete and may be returned. Exhibitor packets will not be given to exhibitors until entry is complete.

- THERE WILL BE A \$125.00 CHARGE FOR ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR ANY REASON.
- THERE WILL BE A \$125.00 FEE FOR STOP PAYMENT OF CHECK FOR ANY REASON.
- THERE WILL BE A \$50.00 DECLINED CREDIT CARD FEE.

**Exhibitors showing in Amateur Owner classes must be listed as an owner of the horse they are exhibiting on the registration papers.

Dressage rides will be limited to three (3) per horse per day and Management has the right to limit it further to two (2). Riders are limited to no more than 2 rides per class. Management has the right to limit entries in Sport Horse in Hand classes.

Post Entries:

Post entries may be made providing an additional fee of \$20.00 per class is paid. Post entries and additional class entries for afternoon and evening sessions must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. Post entries and additional class entries for morning sessions should be made before the end of the last session on the day preceding the class. No post entries accepted for Dressage unless to fill scratches only. **All classes entered at the show, regardless of pre-entries, will be charged post entry fees.**

Withdrawing Entries & Refunds:

Entries may be scratched from the show prior to FEBRUARY 25th, 2026 with a total refund of all fees. After the entry closing date, a refund of class fees will be made only if a written request accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate is received in the show office by 5:00 p.m., March 12th, 2026. There will be a \$125.00 fee for stop payment of a check when withdrawing entries. If check is not made good, AHA, ASHBA & USEF will be notified, and appropriate action will be taken. As a courtesy to other exhibitors and show management, **EACH EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO CANCEL ALL CLASSES THEIR HORSE WILL NOT BE COMPETING IN SO THE GATE WILL NOT BE HELD FOR THEM.**

Registration Requirements:

Horses shown in the Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and must be entered under their full registered name. Horses shown in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry and entered under their registered name.

Indemnity And Assumption Of Risk:

All entries are made and accepted with the understanding that the Missouri Arabian Horse Association will not be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged and each participant assumes the risk of any such injury and recognizes that participation in activities involving horses is inherently risky. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, or any animal, or any property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the Missouri Arabian Horse Association against any and all loss, liability and damages of any kind or nature thus occasioned, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth."

AHA Competition Level Membership Requirements:

Every owner, trainer, driver, rider, and handler must have a valid AHA membership card. Current Competition Level Membership is required for all owners, trainers, riders, drivers & handlers competing in Amateur/Junior classes, or a Single Event Membership must be purchased for \$45 per person on the AHA website. Membership not required for Lead Line, Walk/Trot, or Showmanship 10 & Under classes.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) deadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Arenas: The show will be held in two (2) separate indoor arenas, which have excellent heated facilities for both the horse and rider. The main show arena is 120'x240' with GGT Fiber Footing and the Warm-Up is 100'x200' with GGT Fiber Footing. The Sport Horse Arena is a sugar sand mixture footing. The adjoining warm-up arena is 100'x200' with a sugar sand mixture footing. Exhibitors will be permitted to work horses in the indoor rings between sessions up to one-half hour prior to the start of the session at which time the ring will be closed for show preparation. The show arenas will be open for working horses on Thursday at 9:00 AM and will remain open each day until 10 pm and will reopen for showing the following day.

Calls for Classes: Classes will be called promptly. First call when second class ahead enters the ring; second call when preceding class enters the ring; third call while ribbons are being awarded in the preceding class. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gateman and request a three-minute gate hold. The public address system and class calls are a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their horses at the gate at the prescribed time.

Campers & Horse Trailers: Complete camping facilities and showers are located near the show arena. Reservations are not required, and the facility personnel will collect fees at the show. No vehicles of any kind will be allowed in the arena, paddock or schooling areas. **To reserve your spot, please contact the NEC prior to arriving. www.thenationalequestriancenter.com**

Dogs: Your dogs are welcome at our show. Since we also welcome children, please remember to keep your dog always contained or on a leash for the safety of the children, horses, and your dog. The warm-up ring and show arena building are off-limits for our canine friends.

Officials: In the event that an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules. The judge will break any tie in a jumping class. Exhibitors are warned that any act of courtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove the horse's owner, groom, rider, driver, and/or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Protests: Any protest must be filed in accordance with USEF Rules and/or AHA Code of Ethics rules.

Protective Headgear: Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

Stabling: Those exhibitors wishing to be stalled together must send all entries together in the same envelope. ALL HORSES ENTERED MUST HAVE A STALL. NO SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS. All stalls are permanent 10X10 stalls with doors and are under cover. No stalls will be reserved without payment. All horses stalled must be entered in the show. Bedding must be purchased from the National Equestrian Center. A minimum of two bales are required per horse stall and are \$12 each.

Arrival Time: Horses will be accepted Thursday, March 12th after 8:00 am. Anyone who wants to arrive before this time should advise the manager of your arrival date and time. There will be an additional charge of \$50.00 per day per horse and/or tack stalls for all early arrivals.

Departure Time: All horses must depart the show grounds no later than midnight, Sunday, March 15th. Exhibitors wanting to remain after this time must make special arrangements with the manager and will be charged an additional fee of \$50.00 per day per stall.

Missouri State Health Requirements: An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Missouri. A negative Coggins certificate issued within the past 12 months must accompany all horses. The health and original Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check in. Do not mail with your entry. In case of suspected unsoundness or as a safeguard against communicable disease, all horses are subject to physical inspection by the show veterinarian.

USEF GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturer's or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.

Motorized Vehicles: NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED ON THE NEC GROUNDS.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

TBA CLASSES: TBA Classes are available and will run in the schedule wherever you choose (Example 100A will follow class 100). TBA classes will be held on a first come/first served basis if the sponsorship fee of \$50 plus regular class entry fee (no post to apply) is paid. Send the request with your entry or you can make your request in the show office. There will be no late entry fees for any horse entered in a TBA class. MAHA has the right to limit TBA Classes per session. No Payback in TBA Classes.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. These shows are conducted in accordance with the rules of the USEF, Arabian Divisions.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the USEF Rule book, and particularly the complete Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions and judging specifications. The show committee will decide questions not covered by the USEF Rules, and its decision will be final.

PERFORMANCE DIVISION

To be eligible for Championship classes, horse must have been entered, shown and judged in any class in that division.

HALTER/IN HAND DIVISION

First two place winners of all halter classes may show back in the corresponding championship class if eligible. All Breeding/In Hand classes will use the "In The Ring Class Procedure" and judging will be comparative. **Performance Halter entries must show in a Performance class or will be disqualified.**

DRESSAGE/SPORT HORSE DIVISION

The 2023 USDF/USEF Dressage Tests will be used. Sport Horse in Hand classes will use the Triangle pattern. Refer to USEF Subchapter AR-12. **Dressage and In Hand Entries will be accepted on a first come/first served basis.** Post entries for Dressage and In Hand will be accepted to fill scratched classes, and under the same rules as govern other performance classes. **Dressage rides will be limited to three (3) per horse per day and Management has the right to limit it further to two (2). Riders will be limited to no more than 2 Rides per class. Management has the right to limit entries in Sport Horse in Hand classes.**

****SHIH may not run in Prize List order and some classes could run on Saturday if Dressage entries are light.**

****Sport Horse In Hand and Under Saddle classes will qualify as 2 shows.**

A/HA/AA Warm Up Class: No Fee. Open to all riders. Horses may be shown in Training Equipment and are to be shown at a Walk, Trot/Jog and Canter/Lope. This class will not be judged, and no ribbons will be awarded. A back number is required.

Liberty Class Specifications:

Horses are to be judged on performance, movement, type, presence, and animation. Handler will lead the horse to a designated marker and remove halter. Time and music will start when the halter is removed. While at liberty the horse may perform any gait. Any horse performing any tricks or acts under the apparent control/command of the handler will be disqualified. Only 2 handlers are permitted, and each may carry an approved halter whip. Horse is not to be stood up at halter before being turned loose. Time expires after 2 minutes, and horse will be eliminated if not caught in a further 2 minutes. Each entry will be required to select music and turn into the announcer. 50% of entries to winner.

Academy Class Specifications

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential new owners/riders to the joys of showing and riding horses by giving beginning riders of any breed an opportunity to gain experience by offering beginner classes at our Class A horse shows. Walk/Trot Sections may be provided to allow multiple riders to show the same horse. ***Sections will be assigned at Coach's request.**

RIDERS: Riders are encouraged to be in a professionally operated lesson program. Riding suits and chaps are not allowed. Riding pants, jodhpurs, breeches or colored jeans are considered appropriate. A neatly fitted shirt or top is suggested. A riding helmet is also mandatory for riders 10 and under and suggested for all ages. Appropriate footwear with a small heel is mandatory. Riders are NOT allowed to cross enter into any non-Academy riding classes and are ineligible to compete in Academy classes once they have shown in a full riding suit or in a Class A horse show.

HORSES: Horses are encouraged to be lesson horses of any breed and should display the characteristics of such, but it is not mandatory that they are utilized by in a professional lesson—all horses are welcome, as long as they display good manners and a quiet disposition. A cut-back saddle for saddle seat, western saddle for stock seat, and hunt saddle for hunt seat are to be used. Work bridles and bits, including snaffles, are allowed, and running martingales are permitted and encouraged. However, tie down martingales are not allowed. The horse show management may eliminate any horse or rider that is deemed unsafe or is not abiding by these rules. Academy entries are to follow horse show rules but are not AHA or USEF sanctioned classes. Show grooming is permitted, but not necessary as HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.

JUDGING: All academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horse to its best advantage, and upon the riding skills of the rider. Each class should be judged on the rider's basic equitation and horsemanship skills suited to the class discipline, with emphasis placed on the rider's ability to control the horse at all times, identify correct diagonals and leads promptly, and to control their horses rate in a consistent manner. Riders should convey the impression of good posture, balance, and effective control while commanding proper speed of gaits and show ring placement. Headers are allowed in the lineup in all walk-trot classes. HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED, only the rider's ability to control themselves and their horses and present themselves to their best advantage.

USEF Membership Benefits: USEF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USEF Member Guide or the USEF website at www.usef.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USEF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USEF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USEF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USEF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with affidavit filing fees, A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USEF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in saddle, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owner/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USEF HID requirements are also exempt from the USEF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USEF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$100), 5-years (\$400), or life (\$2,000). A USEF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$80). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan/USEF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USEF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USEF when the member name and dues are submitted to USEF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USEF Rider Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30, and is issued to a business or organization directly by USEF. The USDF BM (\$260) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee, and USDF NM rider, there will be a USEF NM fee of \$55 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USEF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affiliate Form. If the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card, Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USEF NM fee. If there are multiple owners or NM's, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USEF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USEF NM fees not received with the USEF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USEF NM's. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USEF. An individual with a USEF NM identification number is not eligible for any USEF membership benefits. Once USEF NM fees have been assessed, a USEF NM card can be obtained by the USEF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$45). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan/USEF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USEF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$95. If a horse has a USEF LHR and does not need an HID number, an HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$140) is eligible for Adequan/USEF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USEF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USEF

Applications for USEF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Membership (HM), and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:


