If you were able to attend the Sevastopol Town Board meeting, thank you. Your presence made a difference and demonstrated just how much the future of Clark Lake matters to our community.

The Sevastopol meeting showed that our efforts are being noticed. Now it's time for Phase II.

Please join us at the Jacksonport Town Board Meeting on Tuesday, June 23 at 7:00 PM at the Jacksonport Town Hall.

We will be asking the Jacksonport Town Board to take the lead by sending the proposed wake surfing ordinance and condition report to the DNR for its advisory review. The Town Board of Jacksonport has already publicly stated, by enacting an ordinance prohibiting wakesurfing on Kangaroo Lake, that they support this ban on shallow lakes. Clark Lake is shallow with an average depth of 7 feet and no depth of 30 ft or more.

You do not need to speak, except to state your name and address at Meet and Greet, and you are free to leave after the Public Comment portion of the meeting, which is Item #12 on the agenda. Click [here](#) to see the agenda.

Simply showing up sends a powerful message that we care about protecting the lake for future generations.

Support paddles will be provided. Please arrive a few minutes early if possible, as they start at 7PM sharp. The Public Comment section is timed, so please be direct and brief. We showed up in Sevastopol. Let's show up again in Jacksonport and make sure our voices are heard.
