## 7:30 a.m. Check in starts at the Parade Entry Table and will close promptly at 8:30 am.

Only the contact person for each entry need be present to check in. All other participants must be present by 8:30 am. After checking in you will be provided with your Parade Number and Position Assignment.

8:45 a.m. All vehicles and horse trailers must be left at the end of the parade route by the Community Building by this time because the road closes at 9 am.

We will have shuttles available to bring you back to the Parade Starting Point.

For the safety of those gathered to view the parade, no participants will be allowed to drive into the parade area after 9 a.m. There will be no exceptions! We must keep this safe for everyone.

## ELIZABETH LAKE ROAD WILL CLOSE AT 9 a.m. and THE PARADE WILL START AT 10 a.m.
