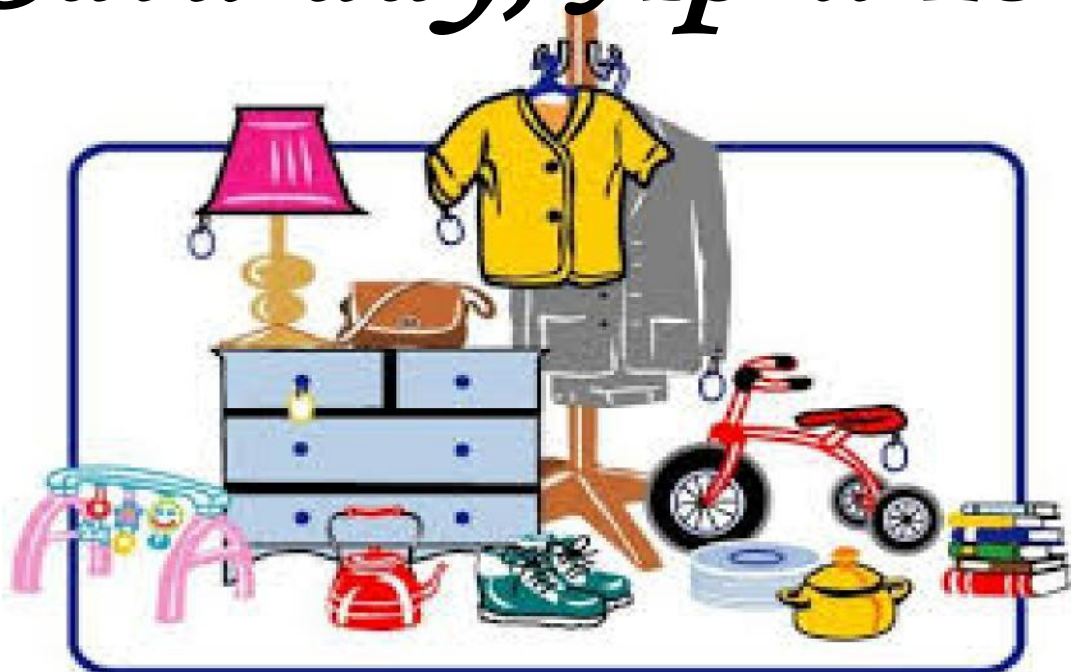

SAVE ON YOUR SALES TAXES

Here is a tip that was brought up at a recent LV Town Council meeting. When ordering online, like from Amazon, our Leona Valley zip code of 93551 brings up Palmdale as the city, along with the City of Palmdale tax rate, which is much higher than ours in the unincorporated area of L.A. County. The way to avoid that is to enter our full zip code with the extra last 4 digits. You can find it at <https://assessor.lacounty.gov/homeowners/property-search>. This should give you a tax rate of 9.75% which can be a big savings, especially on large purchases.
