Looking ahead:

New York State Assessments:

In April and May, students in grades three through six will be taking the New York State English Language Arts and Mathematics Assessments. The testing will take place on the following days. Please note that these dates are changes from the district calendar.

ELA: Grades 5 & 6 – Wednesday, April 19th and Thursday, April 20th

Grades 3 & 4 – Monday, April 24th and Tuesday, April 25th

Math: Grades 5 & 6 – Tuesday, May 2nd and Wednesday, May 3rd

Grades 3 & 4 – Thursday, May 4th and Friday, May 5th

All students will be taking the assessments on the computer. As in previous years, the tests are not timed. The students will have as much time as they need to complete the assessment. The teachers and students have been working diligently all year and we are confident that our students are well prepared for the tests.
