### **STUDENT COUNCIL NEWS**



Dear Lakeside Families,

During our first month of school, we enjoyed seeing our students fill our hallways and classrooms with smiles, motivation, and vigor. They demonstrated their understanding of classroom routines, procedures, materials, and friendships began to form throughout the building. It was exciting to see Lakeside students enthusiastic about their new curricula in all subject areas.

We held our school safety presentations for all grades in the beginning of September. Topics covered were age-appropriate and included the Dignity Act, Bucket Filling, and demonstrating respect and responsibility everywhere.

The **Code of Conduct** was emailed through Parent Square and requires your electronic signature. Please review the Code of Conduct with your child. Additionally, we will hold this type of presentation along with further discussions about dignity and belonging again in the Winter and Spring.

We have been launching our focus on *dignity* and the dignity elements. All students learned what dignity is and how to honor it. Classrooms generated "Imagine Statements" where they envisioned the type of classroom and school they wish for. The students also are learning about the dignity element of *independence*.

**Independence is the ability of individuals to make their own choices, so they feel in control and believe in themselves.** Classrooms will explore the concept of having a growth mindset, setting goals, encouraging others to work on their goals, reflecting on their progress, and identifying problems or obstacles in our lives and/or the world that need to be changed or addressed.







## PRINCIPAL'S PAGE

**Important Dismissal Information:** If you would like to make a change to your child's dismissal (i.e. pick-up, walker, biker, or busser), a request must be made <u>in writing</u>, by the parent or guardian on the day of the change.

Please note the following:

- <u>Send a note in your child's backpack addressed to the teacher</u> on the date of the dismissal change.
- Please <u>do not</u> email or send a Parent Square message to your child's teacher regarding a *day-of dismissal change*. Many times, teachers have limited time during the school day to check their messages and it cannot be guaranteed they will see it before dismissal. Additionally, teachers may be absent, and the substitute teacher in the class would not be notified.
- In an <u>emergency</u> dismissal change, you must <u>call</u> the main office directly at 516-992-7231.

The Nassau County Police will visit Lakeside on *Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup> to speak to grades 5 and 6 about internet safety.*

### HALLOWEEN

On Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, all students (K-6) will be permitted to wear costumes to school.

### Costumes must meet the following criteria to be worn at the Lakeside School:

- Costumes should be fun, happy, and interesting, not gory, violent, obscene, brief/revealing, or mean-spirited.
- Students are not permitted to wear full facial paintings with the intent of being able to safely identify all students and people in the building.
- There will be no weapons permitted as part of any costume including, but not limited to, guns, swords, knives, light sabers, axes, etc.
  - "Group" costumes are highly discouraged. Our school promotes a culture of inclusion, not exclusion. If your child would like to participate in a "group" costume during the school day, please inform and open the invitation to all students in the class.
- We will hold an entire school building parade for our UPK, Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 3.

More details pertaining to the Halloween Parade to follow. Any child that comes to school wearing a costume that is inappropriate based on the above guidelines will be asked to change or cover up his/her costume.
