

FOULING A SHOOTER

- When you foul a shooter, you give them a chance for three (or four) points
- If you must foul, grab the shooting arm forcefully (No lazy fouls that don't bother the shot, but still give the scorer another shot)
- Three-point plays spark teams
- Early in the game, foul shooter not so nervous so better not to foul at all
- When you foul, instead of thinking, "Oh well, that's just my first." (you should think), "I just gave them two points."
- GOOD PLAYERS know the importance of NOT FOULING
- In 'must foul' situations, you must make sure that your intentional foul looks unintentional---GO FOR THE BALL—aggressively—either you will get the steal or whistle blows
