Dr. Mike Barger

Executive Director - Office of Strategy and Academic Innovation at the University of Michigan's Stephen M. Ross School of Business and Professor of Business Administration

Of note in his prior professional roles, Dr. Barger was an Officer in the United States Navy for 13 years, with combat deployments during Operation Desert Storm, and he served as the Chief Instructor for the Navy Fighter Weapons School (TOPGUN). Following his time in the Navy, he became a founding member of JetBlue Airways, JetBlue University, and later led the Emergency Command Center for the company during the 9/11 crisis and Northeast U.S. blackout in 2003. In addition to his administrative role at the University of Michigan, Dr. Barger teaches courses on leadership during complex organizational change.
