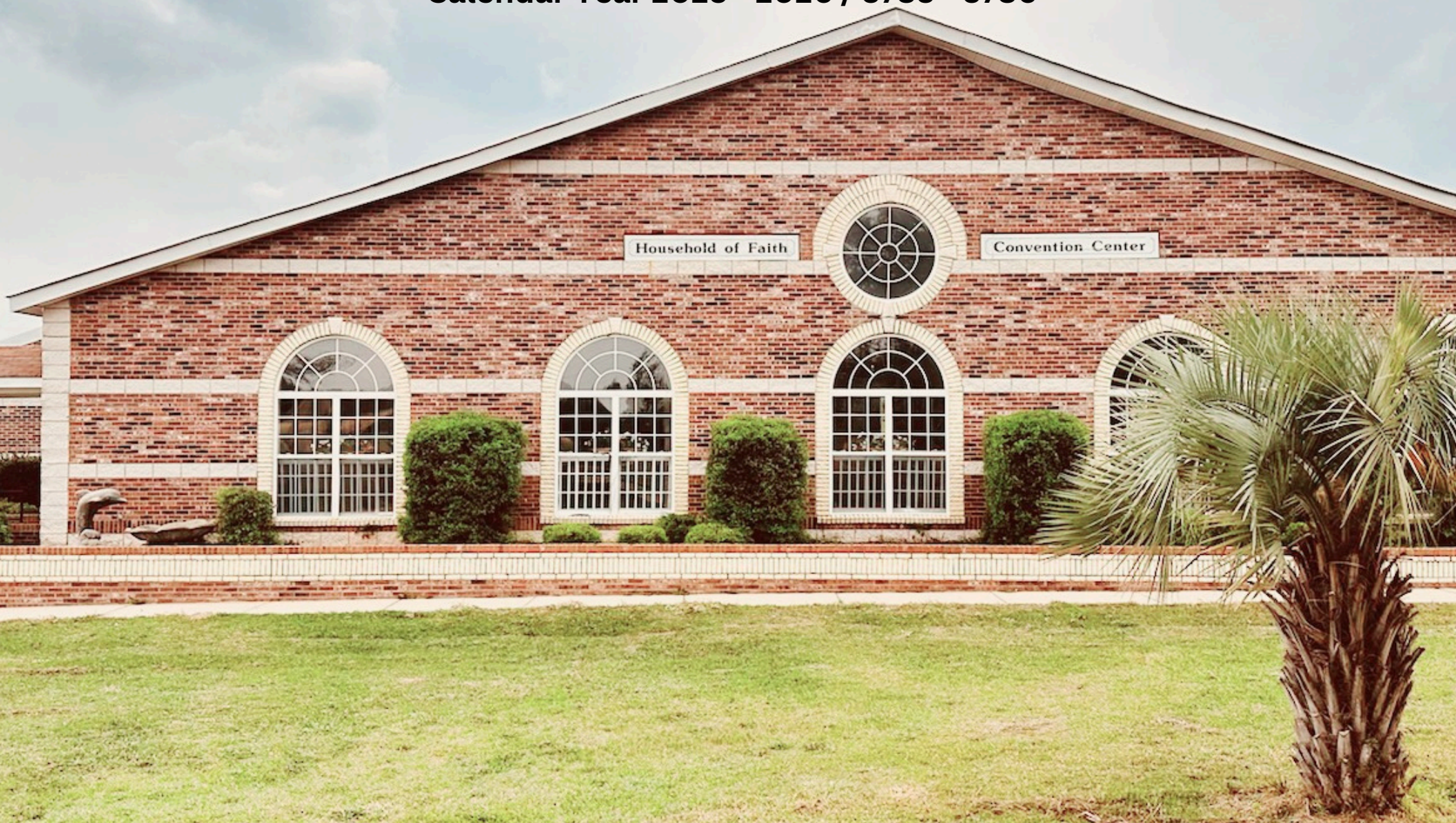

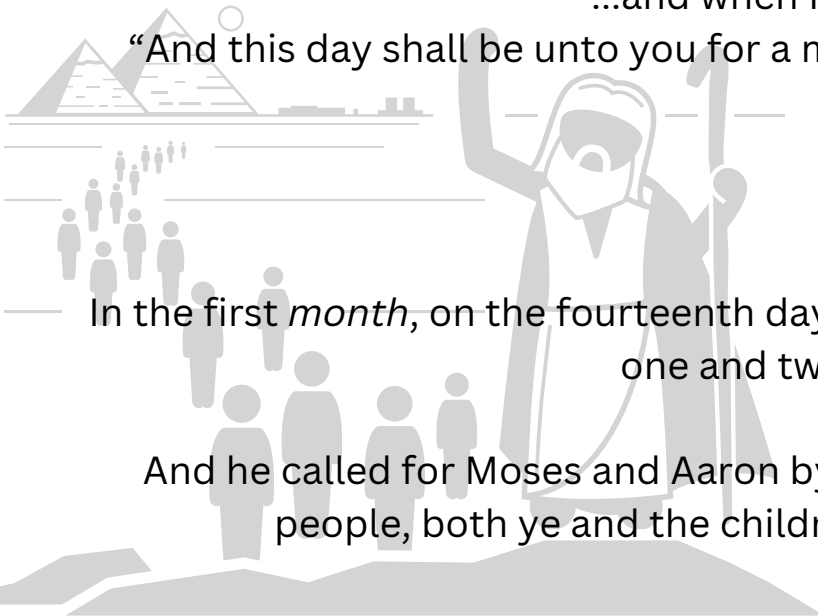
Unleavened Bread



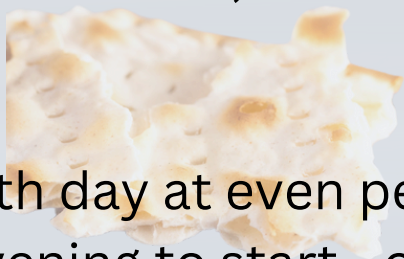

Passover & Unleavened Bread

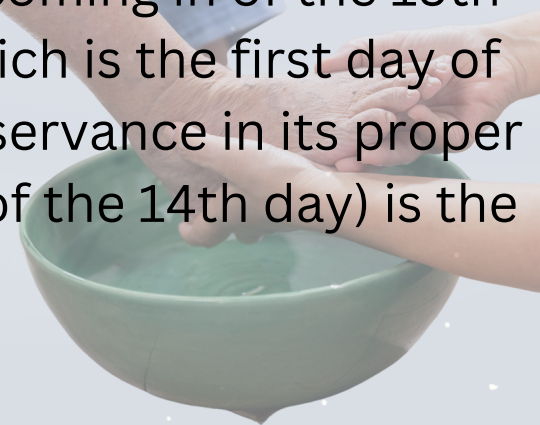
Unleavened Bread

In the first *month*, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.

Exodus 12:18



Fourteenth day at even per nineth day at even (to show specifics between which evening to start - compare the two evenings, start with the day of Atonement - Leviticus 23:32). There is a difference, one speaks of evening bringing in a day/ evening ending a day. (evening to evening meaning a continuous). The nineth at even lets you know to start at the coming in of the 10th day, the 14th at even lets you know to start at the coming in of the 15th day. **To be clear**, the 14th at even starts the 15th day which is the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, putting the Passover observance in its proper place, the 14th at even - Leviticus 23:5 (at the coming in of the 14th day) is the LORD's Passover. * **Exodus 12:6-7***

WHOSE REPORT DO YOU BELIEVE?

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, *there* is no beauty that we should desire him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But *he* was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgement: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in his mouth.

The Creator's Calendar

There are seven days in the creation week (Genesis 1;1-31; 2:1-3). Each day begins at sunset. The beginning of the week, the first day of the week begins after the end of the Sabbath (seventh day) at sunset. Each month begins with the sighting of the first sliver of the new moon (month) or thirty days from the previous new moon if obscured. The beginning of the sacred new year is determined at the new moon when the barley crop in Israel has reached the stage of maturity referred to as Abib - meaning "ear of grain" or "spring"- also marking the beginning of barley harvest and the start of spring.

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:

Colossians 2:16

Leaven / Unleaven

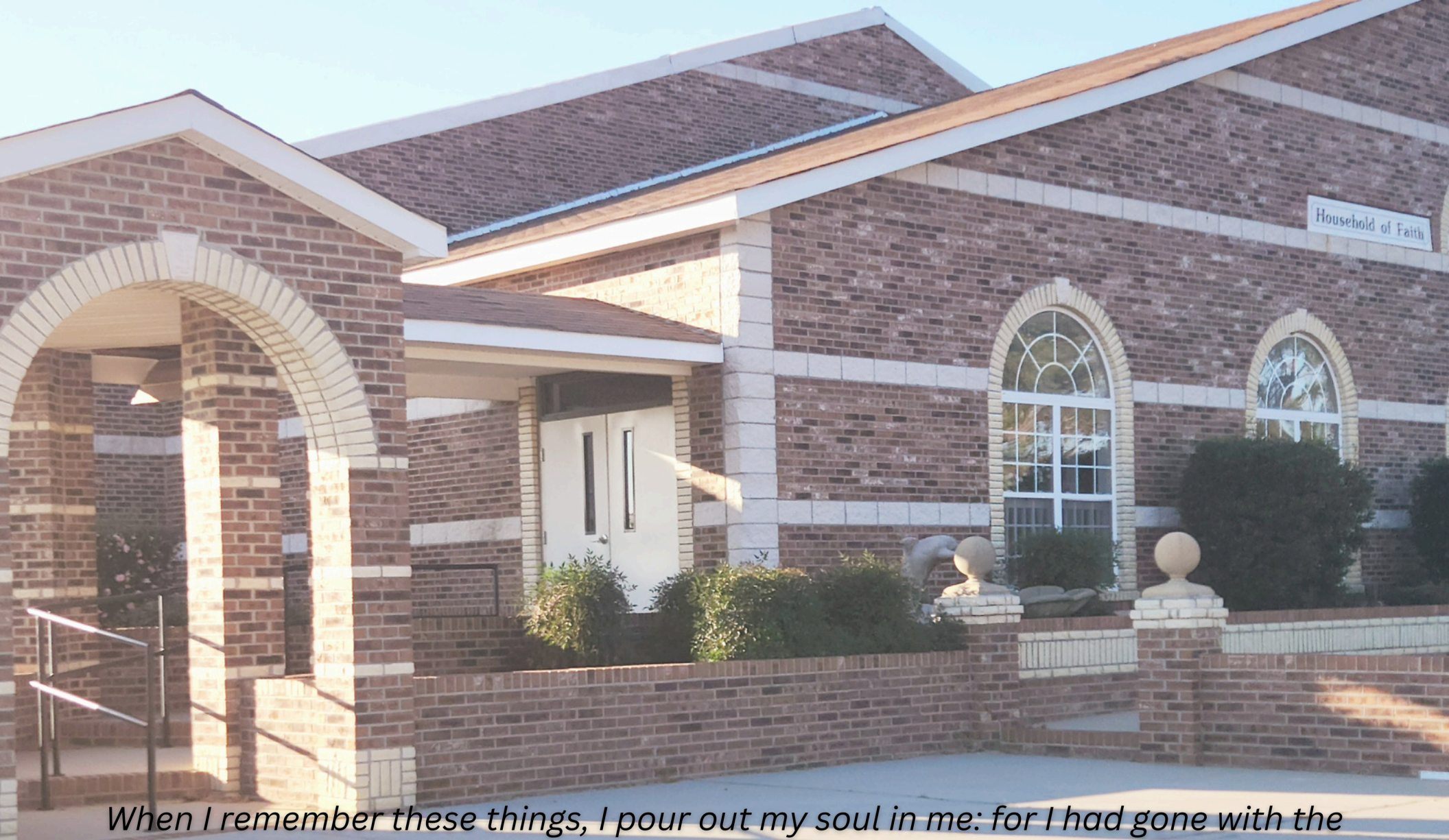
yeast ----- doctrine

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye maybe a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened *bread* of sincerity and truth.

1 Corinthians 5:7-8
