Our approach to health and safety

The health and safety of the local community in Lara and Greater Geelong is of upmost importance to us. Prospect Hill International is committed to providing a safe and healthy working environment for our employees and the wider community. Positive impacts

The Project will employ 300-400 full-time staff during the construction phase, and approximately 30 full-time staff during the operational phase. It is expected that there would also be an increase in indirect employment.

Prospect Hill will target local skills and businesses and areas with higher unemployment for construction and operational workers.



Hazardous waste

Through the operation of the EfW plant, there will be a significant reduction in hazardous waste going to landfill. Waste for our EfW plant will meet EPA's requirements and many metals will be recycled for beneficial use.



Potential health impacts from emissions

The EfW plant is being designed to utilise proven technology to protect air quality and will meet all relevant Victorian, Australian and European emission standards. The EfW plant will be constructed with advanced odour controls which have been successfully implemented at plants around the world. Noise will also be managed through the implementation of noise mitigation measures during detailed design of the plant.



Traffic and Transport

The construction and operation of the EfW plant will see an increase in vehicles using the surrounding road network. However, we will use larger roads designed for these kinds of vehicles such as the Geelong Ring Road and avoid small local roads. Traffic management plans will be developed in consultation with the City of Greater Geelong prior to construction commencing.
