


From President Kay Roach

What about Our Money (2018/2019) - Geography: Latin America, The People of Faith (2015/2016) – The Missionary Conference of The United Methodist Church in The Unites States (2017/2018). Send your report to the designated member of your district Leadership Team by August 31st. Meanwhile, I hope you are making plan to attend **Mission u** July 12-15 at Bethune-Cookman University.

It is not too early to start making plans to carpool to attend the **Conference Spiritual Retreat**, September 7-9, 2018 at the Life Enrichment Center in Fruitland Park (Leesburg). 




