Truman Middle College High School will review each student's transcript to ensure that all required courses are completed prior to graduation. When all the requirements indicated below are met, a secondary education diploma will be awarded to the student.

Graduation Requirements

At Truman Middle College High School. The following requirements must be met in order to qualify for a diploma:

REQUIRED, but not limited to the following courses:	UNITS REQUIRED
English/Language Arts	4 credits
Social Studies	3 credits
World History <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • U.S. History (or a combination of History of the U.S. and American Government) 	0.50 credit 1 credit
Science	3 credits
2 years of laboratory Science, must include Biology or a course integrating Biology.	1 credit
Mathematics	3 credits
Algebra I/Integrated Math I Geometry/Integrated Math II	1 credit 0.50 credit
Fine Arts	1 credit
Foreign Language Vocational/Career/Computer literacy	1 credit
Electives (these may include a selection of courses listed above)	2 credits
Physical Education/Health	1 credit
*Total Credits required: students must earn a minimum of 18 credits as described.	18 Credits

*Most students will graduate with more than 18 credits due to having more than the required number of credits in one or more category.

TMC students take at least 1 English and 1 Math course each term for skill building and STAR exam preparation *Requirements for admission into a 4-year university are slightly different from the above stated requirements

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

- Complete at least one full academic semester at the Middle College.
- Pass the State-Mandated Constitution Test – P.L. 195 = Pass or Fail
- Nine weeks of Consumer Education = Pass or Fail
- Exit with a Tenth Grade Reading Level based on – STAR Test score
- Complete forty (**40**) hours of Community Service (Service Learning Hours), two Service Learning Projects equal to 20 hours each, or a combination of activities and projects equal to 40 hours.
- Take the State-Mandated ACT exam.
- Pass the State-Mandated Constitution Test – PL. 195 = Pass or Fail
- Be exposed to nine weeks of consumer education = Pass or Fail
- Take at least one class with *Civics* Education included
- Complete an individualized plan for postsecondary education, careers, and training in an approved format.
